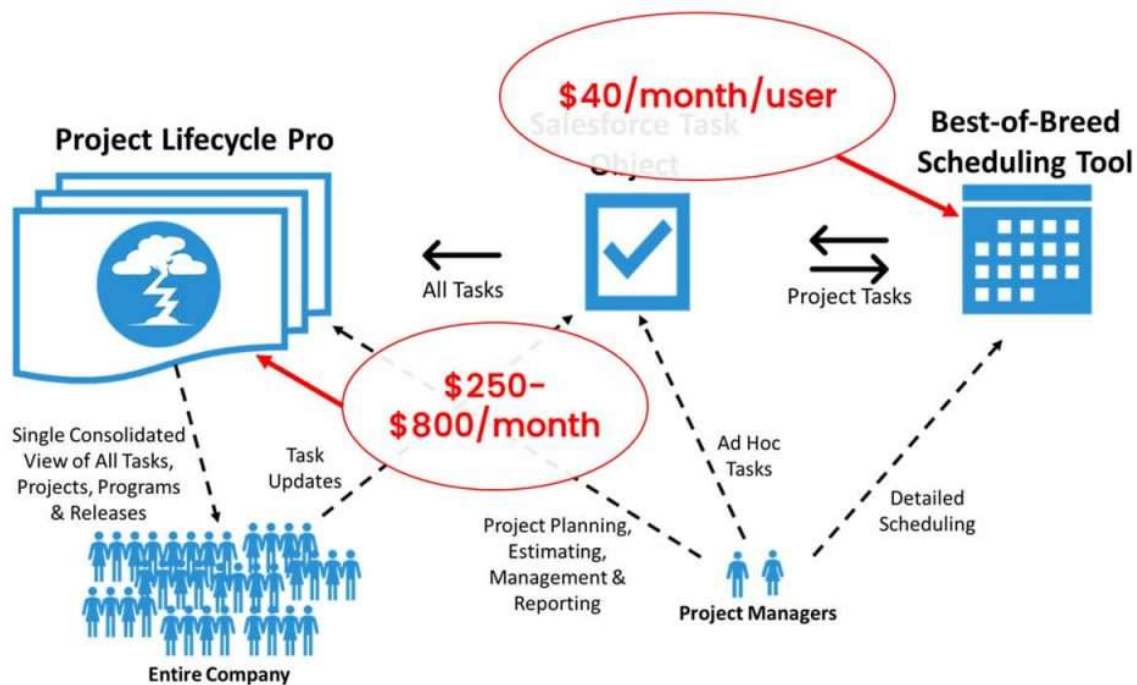


PLP is Affordable

Project Lifecycle Pro (PLP) uses a single site license. This means that for one fixed price everyone in your company can access your project data. Pay the same for 200 employees and 100,000.

PLP uses a single site license because it is focused on collaboration. How can everyone collaborate on projects if you're worried about the cost of purchasing everyone a seat license?

Don't Pay Through the Nose to Access Your Own Project Data



Most project management software and project portfolio management (PPM) tools will also store much of the same project data as PLP. However, if you store your project data in one of these tools you must buy a seat license for everyone who is going to access the project data. That's a license for every executive who wants project status reports. That's a license for any employee assigned a task.

With PLP's approach only the project managers need seat licenses to the scheduling tool. All the other employees are covered by PLP's single seat license. You don't incur any additional cost for giving that executive his project status reports. You don't incur any additional costs by adding an employee to a project team.

Here's the "But" ...

To use PLP everyone must be a Salesforce user on your company license. So, if your company has a Salesforce enterprise license with broad access, then PLP is incredibly affordable because there isn't any incremental cost for additional Salesforce licenses.

But...if you only use Salesforce for Sales and most of the company does not have Salesforce licenses, then PLP would not be cost effective. You'd have to purchase the PLP site license and then Salesforce licenses for all the users.

Small Business \$250/company/month

That's right, only \$250/month for small businesses with less than 100 employees. All the same functionality and benefits at an affordable price.

Large Business \$800/company/month

For the price most PPM and project management tools charge for 20 licenses you can give all your employees access to PLP. You can even choose to pay monthly. Most other software requires paying a year in advanced before you're even a certain it is going to be a fit.
