

Salesforce Site Setup Guide for AppExchange

This guide will walk you through setting up a **Salesforce Experience Cloud site** for publishing on the AppExchange. It includes configuring domain settings, enabling Digital Experience, creating and customizing pages, and organizing navigation.

1. Domain Settings

1. Go to **Setup** in your Salesforce Org.
 2. Search for **Sites** and click on **Domain Settings**.
 3. Go to **My Domain**.
 4. Click on **Register My Salesforce Site Domain**.
 5. Complete the process and **Deploy the New Domain**.
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2. Enable Digital Experience

1. In **Setup**, search for **Digital Experience**.
 2. Click on **Settings** under Digital Experience.
 3. Check the box to **Enable Digital Experience**.
 4. Click **Save**.
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3. Creating the Site

1. In **Setup**, under **Digital Experience**, click on **All Sites**.
2. Click **New**.
3. Choose the **Customer Service** template.
4. Click **Get Started**.
5. Enter a **Name** for your site (e.g., Booking).
6. Use the same name for the **URL**.
7. Click **Create**.

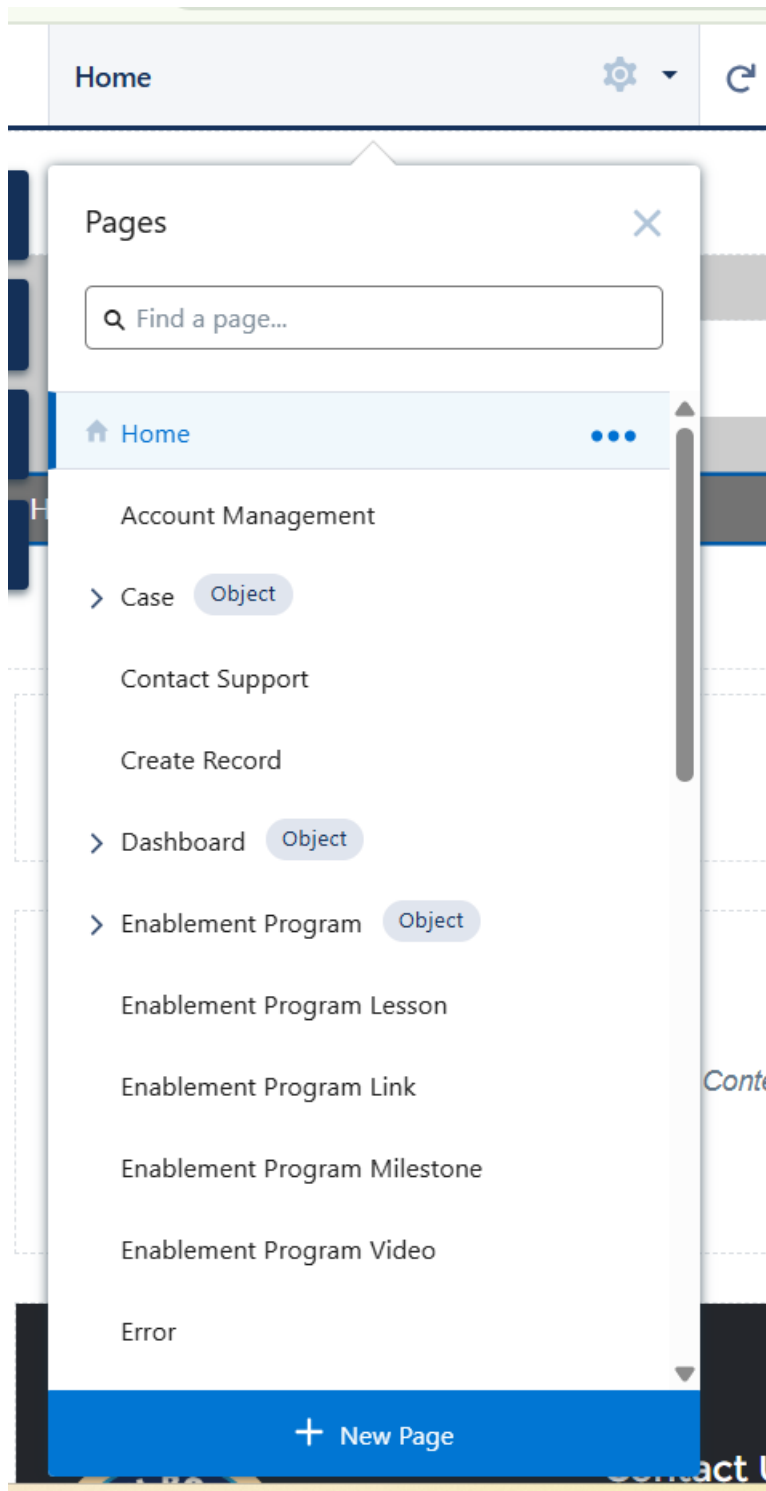
Customize Home Page

1. In the site **Builder**, open the **Home Page**.
2. **Remove** the following components:
 - Ask Question
 - Featured Topics and Feeds
 - Contact Support and Ask Buttons
 - Global Search for Peer-to-Peer Communities
 - Trending Topics

4. Setup Pages

Steps to Create a New Page

1. Open the **Page Dropdown** from the Home page.
2. Click on **New Page**.
3. Choose **Standard Page** → **New Blank Page**.
4. Select a layout of your choice.
5. Provide a **Page Name** and other required details.

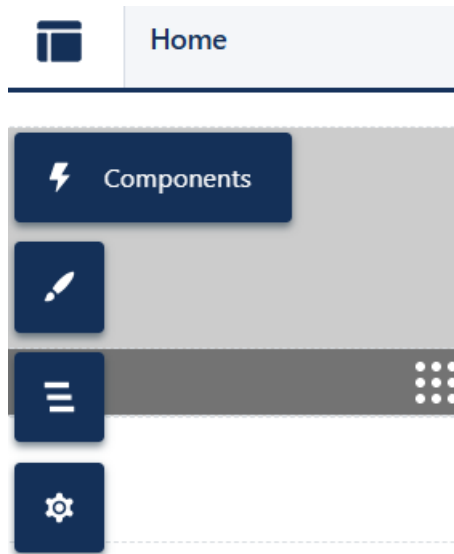

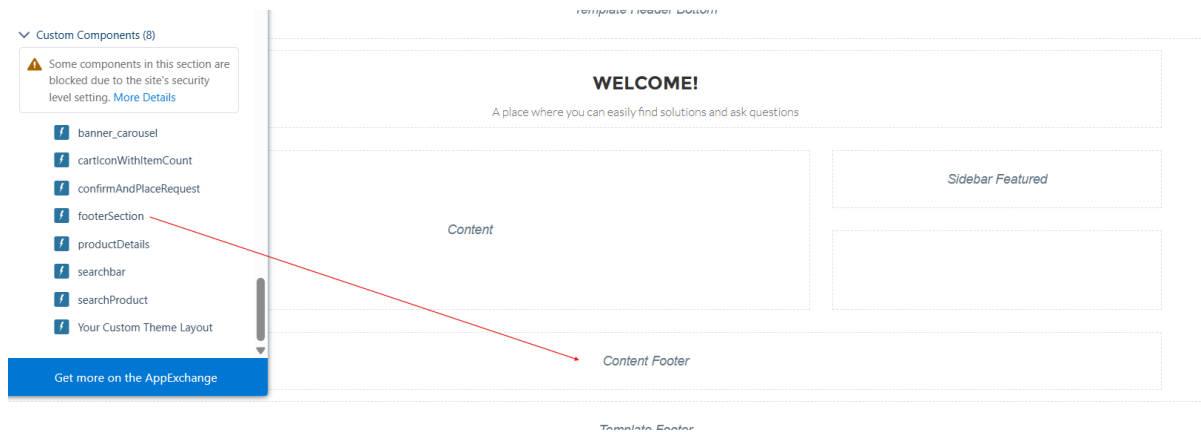
Home Page Setup

1. Hover over the **Components** panel on the left.
2. Under **Custom Components**, drag and drop:
 - currencySelector
 - cartIconWithItemCount

- searchProduct
- footerSection (into Content Footer Section)



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Create Custom Pages

Product Details Page

1. Create a new page named productDetails.
Name:- **ProductDetails** (Required this name)
URL :- **productdetails** (Required for this URL)
API Name: - **ProductsDetails**
Page Access: - Select the **Site default Setting: Public**
2. Add the following components:
 - cartIconWithItemCount

- productDetails
 - footerSection
3. Customize with additional product images and details using HTML.

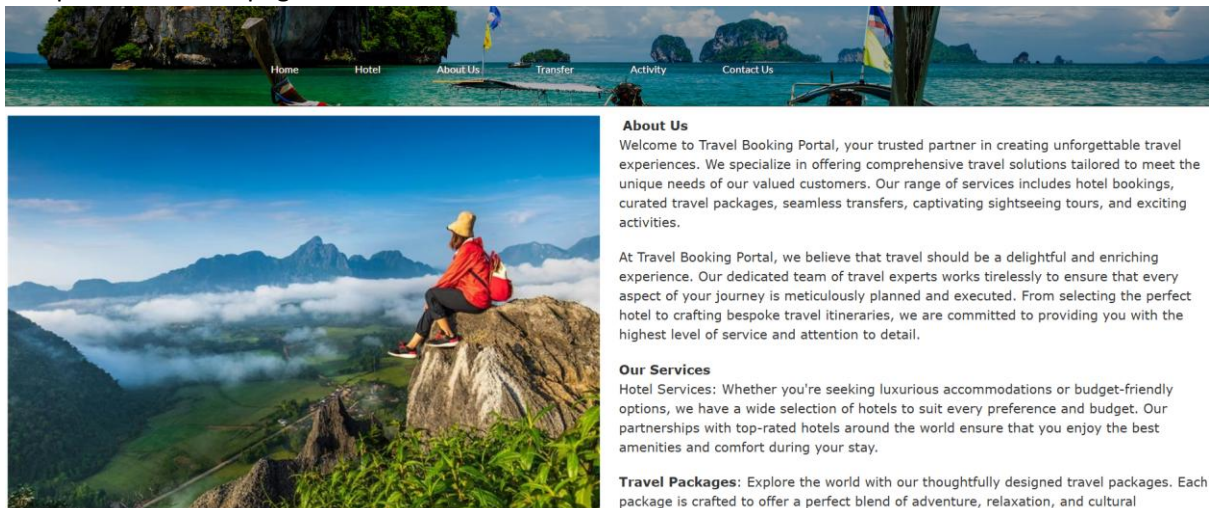
Confirm and Place Request Page

1. Create a new page named `confirmAndPlaceRequest`.
Name:- **ConfirmAndPlaceRequest**(Required this name)
URL :- **confirmandplacerequest**(Required for this URL)
API Name: - **ConfirmAndPlaceRequest**
Page Access: - Select the **Site default Setting: Public**
2. Add the following components:
 - `cartIconWithItemCount`

- currencySelector
- confirmAndPlaceRequest
- footerSection

About Us & Contact Us

1. Create pages named **About Us** and **Contact Us**.
2. Customize by adding:
 - Photos
 - Company details
 - Descriptive text about your services
3. Sample of About Us page



Other Pages

Create additional pages like:

- **Hotels**
- **Activities**
- **Transfers**

Add your custom content and components as needed.

5. Edit Navigation Menu

1. Click on the **Navigation Menu**.
2. On the right panel, check **Hide App Launcher in Header**.

3. Click **Edit Navigation**.
4. **Remove** any unnecessary items like Topics.
5. **Add Menu Items** for the following pages:
 - About Us
 - Contact Us
 - Hotels
 - Activities
 - Transfers

 - Any other introductory message or call-to-action
