Funds

Represents current fund sponsors. A fund sponsor initiates, promotes, and establishes an investment fund. management.

Company Types

<u>Type</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Public Company	A legal entity whose equity is actively trading on any public stock exchange in any country where S&P Global Market Intelligence receives pricing for the company.
Public Investment Firm	A publicly listed firm that makes investments in the form of purchase and sale of public and private equity or debt and other securities, as well as real estate assets. Public Investment Firms may be institutional asset managers, mutual or hedge fund sponsors, pension fund managers, private equity sponsors, or real estate investment firms.
Private Investment Firm	A privately held firm that makes investments in the form of purchase and sale of public or private equity or debt and other securities, as well as real estate assets. Private Investment Firms may be institutional asset managers, mutual or hedge fund sponsors, pension fund managers, private equity sponsors, or real estate investment firms.
Private Company	A legal entity, which is not an investment firm, whose equity does not trade on any public stock exchange. This includes companies listed on a stock exchange where S&P Global Market Intelligence does not receive pricing for the company. This also includes any private company that is also in the Private Company type that also has publicly-owned debt.
Corporate Investment Arm	A principal investment firm (PIF) that is majority-owned by any corporation other than a financial services company or another investment firm. Includes all privately held firms making direct private equity investments and all private equity fund-of-funds that are over 50% owned by another company. Does NOT include any other investment firm type, such as hedge fund sponsors, mutual funds or pension funds, or any publicly traded firms, which are always classified as Public Investment Firms.
Financial Service Investment Arm	Principal investment firm that is majority-owned by a financial services company, such as a bank. Includes all firms making direct private equity investments and all private equity fund-of-funds that are over 50% owned by a financial services company. Does NOT include any other investment firm type, such as hedge fund sponsors, mutual funds or pension funds. Does NOT include firms whose parent company is also an investment firm; these companies are classified as Private Investment Firms, and they are linked to the parent company

	as an Operating Subsidiary.
Private Fund	(AKA Special Purpose Issuer Trust): A fund that is private and managed by an investment firm. Includes structured finance instruments such as asset backed securities and mortgage pass through certificates.
Fund Family	A fund family is the historical succession of funds focused on the same investment strategy. Each fund's success leads to the investment firm's ability to raise more capital for its subsequent funds. When the investment firm creates a fund with a completely new investment strategy, it will also create a new fund family.
Public Fund	Includes ETFs and Mutual Funds as they are tracked as public funds. The majority of these funds have IDC securities that have pricing coming in from IDC.
Educational Institution	Any for-profit or non-profit educational entity, such as universities, schools, colleges, junior colleges, technical institutes, and vocational schools. Does NOT include school boards, school districts, and school divisions which are government institutions, or institutions offering test or exam preparation services, or professional and language training institutes, which are private companies.
Arts Institution	Arts-related entities, such as symphonies, museums, art galleries, and libraries. Related organizations and affiliated endowments are NOT included as Arts Institutions. These are classified as Investment Firms with Endowment Fund Sponsorship as their Investment Type. These firms are linked to their parent.
Labor Union	Includes all unions. Unions are groups who protect laborers and preserve their labor rights. Credit unions are not labor unions; these are classified as Private Companies.
Government Institution	Includes all government-owned agencies or government-run institutions, such as state and country governments, school districts and boards, library districts, workers compensation boards, power and water districts, and military agencies.
Religious Institution	Any religious entity such as churches and temples.
Trade Association	All associations dedicated to a particular trade. Many fields have associations that offer forums for information, as well as accreditations. Fields, such as engineering, medicine, and accounting, have associations dedicated to their particular trade, including Bar Associations. Does NOT include Credit unions and associations related to religion or ethnicity or charitable endeavors.

Foundation / Charitable Institution	Any non-profit organization focused on general philanthropic or social causes. These organizations typically donate funds or provide support to other social organizations, or provide the source of funding for its own charitable purposes. Foundation/Charitable Institutions is a general term and includes public charities (aka charitable foundations, public foundations, or foundations) and private foundations.

Announced/Completed Transactions

Buyback - Change in Plan Terms	When the company announces changes to its plan terms (e.g., increases/decreases the plan term number of shares and/or monetary value and/or plan term percent of shares) and/or changes in duration of the plan (extension/shorten).
Bankruptcy - Conclusion	The key event is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction page when the bankruptcy petition of a company in bankruptcy is either dismissed or the company goes out of business as part of the bankruptcy process. This event is also created when the transaction of a company is consolidated into another bankruptcy transaction (of any of its related entity).
Bankruptcy - Emergence/Exit	This key development is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction screens when a company emerges out of bankruptcy.
Bankruptcy - Filing	This key development is auto-generated from the Bankruptcies transaction page when a company files to reorganize or liquidate under the Federal Court's supervision.
Buyback Tranche Update	In a buyback transaction, the company plans to repurchase a certain amount of its own shares. Typically, the company does not repurchase all the planned shares at the same time; they do it in many operations until they complete the plans. (There are some buybacks transaction that last 4-5 years and beyond). The company discloses the repurchase information either for a quarter/half year/annual or for random periods falling between the duration of the buyback plan. This repurchases information (i.e. how much actually the company has bought back during a particular period (within the entire duration of the plan) is what S&P Global Market Intelligence calls tranches. The Buyback Tranche Update is created when the new tranche repurchased data is created in the transaction. Tranches are created for a minimum of three months except in those cases where the plan is concluded within

	three months or when a quarter lasts fewer than three months.
Buyback Transaction Announcements	Under the Board authorized plans buyback transactions are announced when Board of Directors authorizes a new program to repurchase company's own equity shares. Buyback plans that are mandated through a Shareholder's meeting (Annual/Extraordinary/ Ordinary General Meeting) are shareholders authorized plan. Such buyback transactions are announced from the date of first repurchase under the shareholders authorization program. The only exception to this is when tender offer has been approved by the shareholders. Announcement of such plans are made from the date of mandated given by the shareholders.
Buyback Transaction Cancellations	When a company cancels or forfeits its earlier announced plans to buy back its equity and has not made any repurchases in the plan.
Buyback Transaction Closings	When the company concludes the repurchase program. This key development is created when any of the plan terms have been met, if the duration of the plan has expired, or the date on which the company has suspended the repurchases under the plan.
Composite Units Offerings	A composite unit is an instrument that derives its value from two or more securities underlying it. These Units are transferable and trade like any other security with the holder of the Unit at times having the option to split the Unit in its underlying components and sell them separately.
Debt Financing Related	Announcements that a company is raising money through private placement of debentures, bonds, notes, or mortgages or borrowing directly from financial institutions.
Derivative/Other Instrument Offerings	The public offering of commodities, bonds, equities, currencies, futures, or options by an underwriter for a company.
Fixed Income Offerings	Public Offering of debentures, bonds, and notes by a private or public company.

Follow-on Equity Offerings	An offering of additional shares of equity to the public by a company following the company's initial public offering (IPO).
IPOs	Initial Public Offering: The first sale of stock to the public by a company.
M&A Transaction Announcements	Merger & Acquisition Transactions Announcements: The announcement of the combining of two or more entities into one through a purchase acquisition.
M&A Transaction Cancellations	Merger & Acquisition Transaction Cancellation: The cancellation of an announced transaction between two or more entities seeking to combine into one through a purchase acquisition.
M&A Transaction Closings	Merger & Acquisition Transaction Closings: The finalized transaction which legally outlines the terms of the combination of two or more entities into one through a purchase acquisition.
Private Placements	Announcements of sales of securities directly to institutional investors, such as banks, mutual funds, insurance companies, pension funds, foundations, etc.
Public Offering Lead Underwriter Change	Lead or Co-lead underwriter of a Public Offering is changed after the initial announcement.
Spin-Off/Split-Off	Corporate events pertaining to a Spin-Off/Split-Off transaction. Also, announcements related to closing or cancellation of a Spin-off/Split-off transaction.
Structured Products Offerings	Public offering of Mortgage-Backed (MBS) and Asset-Backed Securities (ABS).

Bankruptcy Updates

Bankruptcy - Conclusion	The key event is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction page when the bankruptcy petition of a company in bankruptcy is either dismissed or the company goes out of business as part of the bankruptcy process. This event is also created when the transaction of a company is consolidated into another bankruptcy transaction (of any of its related entity).
Bankruptcy - Emergence/Exit	This key development is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction screens when a company emerges out of bankruptcy.
Bankruptcy Filing	This key development is auto-generated from the Bankruptcies transaction page when a company files to reorganize or liquidate under the Federal Court's supervision.
Bankruptcy - Other	This event is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction page when a company under bankruptcy files any motion other than the plan, motion for sale or motion for financing. This also includes motions either approved or rejected by the Court or a rumor regarding a potential bankruptcy filing.
Bankruptcy - Asset Sale/Liquidation	The event is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction page when a company in bankruptcy either files a liquidation plan or seeks approval for the sale of its assets in the Court. This event is also created when these motions are either approved or rejected by the Court or any modifications to them are filed by the company.
Bankruptcy - Financing	The event is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction page when a company in bankruptcy is granted Debtor-in-possession financing or exit financing, or any amendment to these financing terms and are approved by a Court.
Bankruptcy - Reorganization	This key event is auto-generated from the bankruptcies transaction page when a plan of reorganization or any amendment to it is filed by a company in bankruptcy. This key event is also generated when such plan are either approved or rejected by the US Bankruptcy Court.

Company Forecasts and Ratings

Corporate Guidance - Lowered	An announcement that a company expects operating results to be lower than its previously announced expectations.
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Corporate Guidance- New/Confirmed	An announcement that a company's expected earnings results or announcements that the company remains confident of the previously announced earnings results.
Corporate Guidance- Raised	An announcement that a company expects earnings results to be higher than its previously announced expectations.

Corporate Structure Related

Address Changes	An announcement that a company's headquarters is moving or has recently moved from one location to another.
Board Meeting	An announcement of the date and agenda of a meeting of a company's board of directors.
Business Reorganizations	An announcement that a company is combining or separating organizational units. Does not cover closure of a unit or facility (see Discontinued Operations/Downsizing) or opening of a new unit of facility (see Business Expansion). The reorganization of a division, management, or operations of a company or corporation for efficiency or cost saving purposes. This may increase the earnings of the company.
Changes in Company Bylaws/Rules	A revision of or a plan to revise the official rules and regulations which govern a corporation's management, which includes changes/ amendments to its Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation.
Executive Changes - CEO	An announcement of the change in executive level CEO position/Co-CEO/additional CEO/Temporary CEO/Joint CEO within a firm, change includes new appointment/ resignation/ retirement/ termination/ demise/ rejoining etc.
Executive Changes - CFO	An announcement of the change in executive level CFO/ Co-CFO/additional CFO/Temporary CFO/ Joint CFO Position within a firm, change includes new appointment/ resignation/ retirement/ termination/ demise/ rejoining etc.
Executive/Board Changes - Other	An announcement of either a change in the membership of an elected member of the board of directors or changes in executive level positions within a firm (excludes CEO & CFO Changes). Executive levels other than CEO& CFO include Chairman, President, Chief Technical Officer (CTO), Chief Operating Officer (COO), Chief Compliance Officer (CCO) etc. Change includes new appointment/ resignation/ retirement/ termination/ demise/ rejoining etc.

Fiscal Year End Changes	An announcement that a company changes/ redefines the end of its annual reporting period.
Legal Structure Changes	An announcement that a company changes the legal structure of the business. Changes include changing to a Public Company, changing to a Private Company, changing to Limited Liability Company, Changing from Open Joint-Stock Company to Joint-Stock Company etc.
Name Changes	An announcement that a company changes or plans to change its name.

Customer/Product Related

Business Expansions	The growth of a company, usually by means of increasing their current operations through internal growth, like entering into new markets with existing product, opening a new branch, establishing a new division, increasing production capacity, investing additional capital in the current business. Growth by acquisition is not covered in this type.
Client Announcements	An announcement of the beginning, ending or change in a relationships between a corporation and their clients or potential future clients.
Product Related Announcements	Announcements pertaining to the introduction, change, improvement, or discontinuation of a company's product or services. This includes all announcements from the research to final launch of the product and any enhancements to the product after launching along with announcements related to product recalls. This covers introducing/announcing/unveiling a new product/service/software/solution/platform and technology along with new product line, new models, brands, and new versions of its products or services. This event covers announcements related getting permission/receiving patent rights for releasing new product into the market. For Pharma industry each stage of the new product trails will be covered. For Drilling/Exploration industry when the company releases study results, commences drilling, releases drilling results.
Strategic Alliances	An agreement between two or more entities stating that the involved parties will collaborate in some way to achieve a common goal. This also includes discussions when the two or more companies intend to form an alliance. Collaboration may include forming an alliance to develop a new product; conduct research activities together; integrate their products or services or technology into new solution or as joint solution; forming an alliance to start a new company; entering into joint venture agreement; extend / terminate their previously announced strategic alliance / research collaboration agreement; airline company enters into code sharing agreements.

Dividends/Splits

Dividend Affirmations	When a company reiterates a previous dividend announcement or announces that they will continue to pay the same dividend that they have paid in the past. This only includes dividends paid in cash.
Dividend Cancellation	When a company cancels an already announced dividend or suspends or omits to pay a dividend.
Dividend Decreases	When a company either announces that they will be paying a dividend that is lower than was previously announced or announces that they will pay a lower dividend than they have paid in the past. It only includes dividends paid in cash.
Dividend Increases	When a company announces that they will be paying a dividend that is higher than was previously announced, announces that they will pay a higher dividend than they have paid in the past or announces that they will begin paying a regular dividend. (Declarations of non-periodic dividend payments are covered under "Special Dividend Announced" defined below.) This only includes dividends paid in cash.
Dividend Initiation	When a company announces its maiden dividend or reinitiates dividend payment after a long gap.
Ex-Div date (Regular)	The first day of the ex-dividend period for a periodically recurring dividend. An investor who does not own the stock before this date will not be eligible to receive the dividend.
Ex-Div Date (Special)	The first day of the ex-dividend period for a non-periodic dividend. An investor who does not own the stock before this date will not be eligible to receive the dividend.
Preferred Dividend	When a company announces dividend payments on preferential shares. This only includes dividends paid in cash.
Special Dividend Announced	An announcement of a non-recurring distribution of company assets, usually in the form of cash to shareholders.
Stock Dividend (<5%)	A dividend payment made in the form of additional shares rather than a cash payout whose value is less than 5% of the value of the shares held. Stock dividends greater than 5% are considered "Stock Splits & Significant Stock Dividends".
Stock Splits & Significant Stock Dividends	When a company increases the number of outstanding shares of its stock but the proportionate equity of each shareholder remains the same.

Investor Activism

Investor Activism - Activist Communication	Any type of communication from the Activist (firm/person) to a Target firm or Shareholders of the Target on activism agendas. Usually communication is made through SEC filings, letters/emails, press releases, power point presentations etc.
Investor Activism - Agreement Related	Any agreements entered into between Activist and Target related to a campaign. These include Settlement Offers either by Target/Activist, Settlement agreements, Standstill agreements, Confidentiality agreements, or any other disclosure which denotes information suggesting a settlement between the two firms.
Investor Activism - Financing Option from Activist	When an Activist offers financing to Target or Target lenders during a campaign and/or with an activism agenda.
Investor Activism - Nomination Related	Disclosure of nomination related information either by the Target or Activist. These include intent/notice of nominations to the Board by Activist, responses of Target on Activist nominations, and withdrawal of nominations by Activist.
Investor Activism - Proposal Related	All shareholder proposal related information, including proposals made or withdrawn by Activist, and responses of Target on the proposals made by Activist.
Investor Activism - Proxy/Voting Related	Covering Proxy fight related information, including solicitation of proxies by Activist and/or Target during a campaign, and Declaration of voting results by Target firm.
Investor Activism - Supporting Statements	Including the statements issued by Independent Proxy Advisors, and supporting statements made by a third party on Activist/Target during a campaign.
Investor Activism - Target Communication	All communications from the Target firm to Activist or Shareholders of the Target on activism agendas. Usually communication is made through SEC filings, letters/emails, press releases, power point presentations etc.

Listing/Trading Related

Delisting	An announcement that a company's common stock either has been or is scheduled to be removed from its primary exchange. Both voluntary (e.g. SEC Form 15 filers) and involuntary (i.e. companies that have received non-compliance notices from their respective stock exchanges).
End of Lock-up Period	The end of a period of time which an investment may not be sold. In conjunction with a Public Offering, a company and its underwriter typically enter into a lockup agreement to ensure that shares owned by these insiders do not enter the public market too early after the offering.
Exchange Changes	When a company moves from one primary stock exchange to another.
Index Constituent Adds	An announcement that a company has been added to a stock index.
Index Constituent Drops	An announcement that a company has been removed from a stock index.
IPOs	Initial Public Offering: The first sale of stock to the public by a company.
Ticker Changes	When a public company changes its stock ticker to a different ticker in its primary stock exchange, or when an exchange forces a change due to a delisting or other action.

Potential Red Flags/Distress Indicators

Auditor Changes	Announcements related to change of external auditor in a firm.
Auditor Going Concern Doubts	When an auditor for a company has doubts about the accounting statement of their client company's reaffirmation that it will continue to stay in business.
Bankruptcy - Filing	This key development is auto-generated from the Bankruptcies transaction page when a company files to reorganize or liquidate under the Federal Court's supervision.
Business Reorganizations	The reorganization of a division, management, or operations of a company or corporation for efficiency or cost saving purposes. This may increase the earnings of the company.
Debt Defaults	Usually companies borrow money, based on some standard and agreed repayment schedule. Sometimes debt providers demand companies repay

	the debt before scheduled maturity dates in situations where the company fails to perform its obligations under the Indenture. This pertains to these situations which are cause for the accelerated debt payment. These kinds of situations may lead a company to a cash crunch and may also lead to a change in the company's debt structure.
Delayed Earnings Announcements	When a company postpones the release of earnings results/operating results to the public.
Delayed SEC Filings	When a company does not file appropriate corporate documents or filings with the SEC by the appropriate deadline.
Delistings	An announcement that a company's common stock has been or is scheduled to be removed from its primary exchange. Both voluntary delistings, such as SEC Form 15 filers, and involuntary delistings, such as companies that have received non-compliance notices from their respective stock exchanges, are covered under this event type. This key development is only processed for companies that have not been delisted because of an M&A transaction. Common stock and ADR's & GDR's are processed and no other form of listed security is considered for making this key development. Once the company regains compliance this key development is also included in Delistings.
Discontinued Operations/Downsizings	Announcements pertaining to phasing out of a product line, closing of an individual facility (e.g. a plant, branch, division or subsidiary) or a reduction in the work force of a company.
Halt/Resume of Operations - Unusual Events	Announcements pertaining to halt or resume of operations due to unusual events like natural calamities, fire etc.
Impairment/Write Offs	A reduction in the value of an asset or earnings by the amount of an expense or loss. This is usually reduced as a result of poorly estimated losses or gains. Generally companies write off their assets to ensure that their assets are not overstated in the company's financial statements. Whenever a company recognizes an impairment loss, there will be a change in the assets of the company, and will also affect the earnings of the company.
Investor Activism - Activist Communication	Any type of communication from the Activist (firm/person) to a Target firm or Shareholders of the Target on activism agendas. Usually communication is made through SEC filings, letters/emails, press releases, PowerPoint presentations, etc.
Labor-Related	Announcements pertaining to the labor force of a particular company,

Announcements	including changes in agreements between a company and its employees' union and when a company enters into an agreement with the US Labor Department in respect to workers contract. This also covers announcements related to company's labor/trade union calls/warns/ends a strike against company.
Lawsuits & Legal Issues	This pertains to actions or suits brought before a court against a company, as to recover a right or redress a grievance. This covers lawsuit is filed against the company, updates on the on-going hearings, court delivers verdict against/ in favor of company in a lawsuit, company settles disputes with other parties and court / legal authority seeks additional information from the company.
Regulatory Agency Inquiries	Includes announcements that the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)/ Securities regulatory agencies in respective countries launching an inquiry into a company or Securities regulatory agencies files lawsuit against company or Company announces settlement / termination of Securities regulatory agencies investigation, or Securities regulatory agencies seek information from a company. This also covers change in accounting policy of a company or a change in the auditor of a company.
Regulatory Authority - Compliance	Announcements such as approvals, licenses, permissions, certification, objections, challenges etc. from federal regulators or government agencies that influence companies or industry.
Regulatory Authority - Enforcement Actions	Announcements such as complaints, fines, penalties, investigations etc. from federal regulators or government agencies that influence companies or industry. This also covers events talking about enforcement actions by Regulatory Authority against companies or events talking about investigations against company initiated by Regulatory Authority.
Restatements of Operating Results	Pertinent to whenever there is a revision to a company's earlier financial statements. The need for restating financial figures can result from fraud, misrepresentation, change of accounting policy or a simple clerical error.

Potential Transactions

Considering Multiple Strategic Alternatives	When a company is evaluating a range of alternatives/options/measures to enhance shareholder value which may include, sale, IPO, mergers and acquisitions, joint ventures, partnerships, strategic alliances, financing, recapitalization, share buybacks etc. This is important to strategic/financial buyers and investment/consulting firms that are interested in finding new investment possibilities or clients as the case maybe.
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M&A (Merger & Acquisition) Rumors and Discussions	Pertinent to rumors/confirmed announcements for potential or initial talks for a merger, acquisition, and stake sale involving company(s) before any actual agreement is signed between the target(s) and buyer(s). This development also includes denials pertaining to merger/acquisition/sale talks amongst the concerned companies.
Potential Buybacks	Pertinent to speculations or intentions of a company to announce a buyback plan or where a company is seeking shareholder's approval through Annual General Meeting, Extraordinary General Meetings etc. to launch a Buyback plan.
Potential Privatization of Government Entities	Announcements that pertain to the potential conversion of ownership in a government/state-controlled entity to private or public ownership through the means of share sale, auction, tender offer, etc.
Seeking Acquisitions / Investments	This development is used when a company seeks to acquire or purchase a majority or minority interest in other companies/assets/divisions/subsidiaries/brands/products etc. Also, this development is used when a company is looking at specific markets/sectors, where it already does not operate, for investment purposes.
Seeking Financing/Partners	When a company seeks equity funding/venture capital for general corporate purposes. The development is also used when a company is looking for joint ventures, partnerships, and strategic alliances. This may also include companies looking at the possibility of raising funds through an Initial Public Offering before the appointment of advisors/underwriters/lead managers and prior to the filing of the prospectus.
Seeking to Sell/Divest	This development is used in cases where a company is looking for a complete or a partial sell-off or a spin-off of its assets, divisions, subsidiaries, brands, properties etc. The development is also used when a company is looking at divesting its stake in another company. The companies, which have denied/withdrawn from a potential sale/spin off are also included in this key development.
Shelf Registration Filings	A term used for the SEC rule 415, which allows a corporation the ability to comply with registration requirements up to 2 years before making a public offering. The corporation must still file the required annual and quarterly reports to the SEC.

Analyst/Investor Day	This pertains to events conducted for Analyst/Investor to update issues related to company.
Announcement of Interim Management Statement	Announcements of periodic Interim Management Statement.
Announcement of Operating Results	Announcements of quarterly, annual, or other periodic operating results.
Announcements of Earnings	Announcements of quarterly, annual, or other periodic earnings.
Announcements of Sales/Trading Statement	Announcements of results exclusively for reporting sales/revenue/turnover results for a particular period.
Annual General Meeting	The Annual General Meeting of a company is usually held at the end of each fiscal year, at which time the previous year and the outlook for the future are discussed, and directors are elected by common shareholders. Shortly before each annual meeting, the corporation sends out a document called a proxy statement to each shareholder.
Company Conference Presentations	This pertains to when a company participates in a "Conference" conducted by third parties, to discuss any issues with its Shareholders \ Analysts \ Investors.
Conferences	Events hosted by investment companies where various companies participate to update analysts, shareholders, investors etc. regarding issues related to company.
Corporate Guidance - Unusual Events	An announcement that a company expects impact on operating results due to unusual events like natural calamities, fire etc.
Delayed Earnings Announcements	When a company postpones the release of its earnings to the public.
Delayed SEC Filings	When a company does not file appropriate corporate documents or filings

	with the SEC at the appropriate deadline.
Earnings Calls	This pertains to when a company conducts a "Conference Call" to discuss its quarterly, annual, or other periodic earnings results.
Earnings Release Date	This pertains to the future dates communicated by a company, when its Earnings Results will be announced.
Estimated Earnings Release Date (S&P Global Derived)	Estimated future dates of Earnings release. It is auto generated based on historical earnings announcements dates.
Fixed Income Calls	Quarterly, annual, and other periodic conference call conducted by the company to discuss updates/earnings results with its fixed income investors.
Guidance/Update Call	This pertains to when a company conducts a "Conference Call" to discuss its guidance/ expectations for the future periods or to update its shareholders / analysts / investors on its operations during a particular period.
Interim Management Statement Calls	A conference call conducted by the company to discuss its periodic interim management statement.
Interim Management Statement Release Date	Scheduled release date of periodic Interim Management Statement.
M&A (Merger & Acquisition) Call	This pertains to when a company conducts a "Conference Call" to discuss or to update its shareholders/ analysts/ investors on Mergers and Acquisitions related issues.
Operating Results Calls	A conference call conducted by the company to discuss its quarterly, annual, or other periodic operating results (other than earnings results).
Operating Results Release Date	Scheduled release date of company's quarterly, annual, or other periodic operating results (other than earnings results).
Preferred Stock Buybacks	Repurchase of outstanding Preferred shares by a company in order to reduce the number of preferred shares in the market. Companies buyback preferred

	shares to increase the value of shares (reducing supply), or to reduce recurring fixed dividend payment burden.
Regulatory Authority - Regulations	Announcements related to rules, regulations, guidelines, policy statements etc. from federal regulators or government agencies that influence companies or industry.
Restatements of Operating Results	The restatement of a company's announcement of operating results due to needs for a correction or change in the initial announcement. This pertains to whenever there is a revision in a company's earlier financial statements. The need for restating financial figures can result from fraud, misrepresentation, change of accounting policy or a simple clerical error.
S&P Events	This pertains to events conducted by Standard & Poor's.
Sales/Trading Statement Calls	Includes all Conference Calls regarding sales, trading, or other results except earnings results.
Sales/Trading Statement Release Date	Future dates when Sales, Trading, or other operating results will be released.
Shareholder/ Analyst Calls	This pertains to when a company conducts a "Conference Call" to update its shareholders and analysts on any special issues related to the company other than earnings and expectations. This also pertains to when a Company announces Webcast of its AGM.
Special Calls	This pertains to when a company conducts a "Conference Call" to discuss any special issues (product launches, Joint ventures, expansions, strategic alliances etc.).
Special/ Extraordinary Shareholders Meeting	A meeting other than the annual general meeting between a company's shareholders, executives and any other members. An EGM is usually called on short notice and deals with an urgent matter. As an EGM usually deals with matters which are urgent and need to be discussed before the next annual general meeting and requires approval of shareholders.
