However, Files Connect lacks the advanced capabilities required for document management in Salesforce. It enforces file size restrictions and search functionality is less advanced than the native search capabilities of platforms like SharePoint, OneDrive, AWS S3, and Google Drive. Additionally, Files Connect lacks a direct upload option from local devices, requiring files to be uploaded to external storage first. Permission control is also restricted, relying on the external storage provider's settings rather than offering granular control within Salesforce.

APIs and Custom Development

Salesforce APIs (REST and SOAP) can be used to create a more personalized Salesforce document management solution. The downside is that it requires technical expertise, time-consuming, from initial design to setup, making this option less practical for organizations looking for a quick and cost-effective solution.

Salesforce's AppExchange offers a variety of third-party document management apps. These pre-built apps integrate seamlessly with Salesforce, offering a range of benefits such as quick and easy installation, cost savings, advanced features like e-signatures, automated workflows, and real-time collaboration.
