1. End User View Updates

1.1 Column Expansion

- Columns can now be manually expanded within the table view, giving users more control over how data is presented across wider or narrower fields.

1.2 Wrap Text / Clip Text on Columns

- For columns containing large text values, users can now toggle between two display modes:
 - Wrap Text — displays the full content across multiple lines within the cell.
 - Clip Text — keeps the row height fixed and truncates overflowing text, keeping the table compact.

1.3 Formatter Expansions

Rich Text Fields

- Rich text fields are now rendered inside the table view with formatting preserved.
- Long rich text content is truncated to a configurable character length to keep the table readable, with the full content accessible on record open.

Mailto Links for Email Fields

- Email fields now render as clickable mailto links, allowing users to open their email client directly from the table without copying the address manually.

Lookup Field Redirect

- Lookup fields are now clickable and redirect the user directly to the related child or master record.
 - A visual indicator distinguishes whether the field is a Lookup (child record) or a Master record reference, so users always know where they're navigating.
 - Clicking redirects the user to that record directly from within the table — no extra navigation steps needed.

Note: *Field-type restrictions apply — not all field configurations support the redirect behaviour.*

1.4 Action Modifications

- Users are now given an explicit choice when triggering an action, providing a confirmation step before the action executes.
- Delete action improvement: after a row is deleted, the user remains on the same page rather than being redirected, preserving scroll position and context.

1.5 Kanban View with Picklist Filter

- Users can now switch from the standard Table view to a Kanban view with a single click.
- The Kanban view supports filtering by picklist field, making it easy to segment and visualise records across different states or categories.

1.6 Sorting at Child Level

- Sorting is now supported at the child record level within related tables, giving users finer control over how child data is ordered and displayed.

2. Admin View Updates

2.1 Sortable and filterable toggles removed

- The sortable and filterable in the step 4 column configuration removed the options for toggling sortable and filterable.

3. Technical Updates

3.1 Bug Fixes

- Several minor bugs identified since the v2.1 release have been resolved in this update for improved stability and performance.

3.2 QA & Testing

- Validated rendering of long table names in PDF exports — extended titles now display correctly without truncation or layout breakage.

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
