Version 4.8-rc.23/ 4.8

This release contains the following enhancements:

1. Legacy Aura data tables have been deprecated and are no longer supported.
2. A new Search / Filter feature has been added.
3. Display of Rich Text is now supported.
4. Fixed popup window cutoff / truncation which occurred in setup/configuration.

Version 4.7-rc.22 / 4.7

This release fixes the table rendering issue which occurs when Lightning Web Security is enabled in Setup -> Session Settings.

Version 4.0.0-rc.21 / 4.1

This release contains the following bug fix:

- 1) Set Wrap Text in column drop down when column defaults to Wrap Text. In the prior release it always indicated Clip Text even if column was configured to default to Wrap Text.

Version 3.9.0-rc.19 / 3.9

This release contains a new Lightning Web Component that provides the following features:

- 1) A single Flow Data Table component is provided that supports most standard and all custom objects. You no longer need to generate tables for your objects.
- 2) Initial column widths can now be specified for each column.
- 3) Wrap text can now be specified for each column.
- 4) Support for newer standard objects such as ContactPointAddress.
- 5) This version is backward compatible with any previously installed version of this product. However, you will need to use the new Flow Data Table in order to utilize the initial width and wrap text features.

Version 3.5.0-rc.15 / 3.5

Corrected JavaScript error which occurred when a flow was run in an Aura component. When the Aura component handled the flow's finish event and navigated to another page an error was displayed to the user.

Version 3.4.0-rc.14 / 3.4

Added support for Rich Text fields such as formula fields that output HTML and Rich Text Area fields.

Version 3.3.0-rc.13 / 3.3

This version contains the following enhancements:

1. Support text wrapping for all field types.
2. Add property to the Data Table so that the number of records that are loaded on a mobile device is configurable. In the past this was hard coded to 3 records. This new feature affects the number of records initially loaded and the number of records loaded when the Load More button is selected.
3. Add a custom profile to the Managed Package which Apex tests will utilize. In past releases Apex used Standard User Profile and test could fail if access rights were assigned to the Test Data Table Custom object.
4. Enable mobile view when the Data Table is displayed on a tablet device.



Version 3.2.0-rc.11 / 3.2

This version contains the following enhancements:

1. Add Delete Table page to the utility application.
2. Provide support for Professional Edition orgs that do not have API feature enabled.
3. Add the Run Data Table Permission Set to prepare for the Summer '20 Critical Update.
This update requires user profiles and permission sets to have access to Apex classes that are invoked by Lightning Web Components.
4. Display busy indicator when user sorts records.
5. Enhance editing so if user edits cell then clicks on another cell the prior cell's edited value is saved. Previously you had to click to a non-cell area of the table to save.
6. Correct the defect that occurred when editing a cell with an undefined value it was incorrectly initialized with a previously edited cell's value.
7. Provide support for editing two tables on the same flow screen that display different object data.

Version 2.10.0-rc.9 / 2.10.0

This version contains the following enhancements for Ultimate beta test features:

1. Corrected defect that occurred when editing in a Flow Action the edit window was displayed outside of table.
2. Corrected defect when editing right column values the edit window would sometimes get cut off.
3. Corrected defect where field edits would be lost in some cases when a DML save error occurred.

Version 2.9.0-rc.8 / 2.9.0

This version corrected a defect that occurred when an integer was in the field set which caused a range error exception. This only occurred on standard fields such as DurationInMinutes on the Event object. Custom fields were not impacted by this defect.

Version 2.8.0-rc.7 / 2.8.0

This version contains the following enhancements:

1. Corrected defect when browser font set to very small the vertical scroll bar would not appear on non-mobile devices.
2. Changed configuration property *Max Table Height* to *Table Height*. This property sets a fixed table height. The behavior of the feature is unchanged.

Version 2.6.0-rc.5 / 2.6.0

This version contains changes that enhance the editing features when used on Android and iOS devices. These changes will not be visible in the free version unless the Pro and Ultimate features are enabled for beta testing.



Version 2.5.0-rc.4 / 2.5.0

This version contains the following enhancements:

1. We now support mobile devices! The table can be displayed on both Android and iOS. Both the existing and the new Salesforce mobile applications are supported. See FAQ if you plan to beta test the Pro and Ultimate features on a mobile device.
2. All lookup fields will have their parent names displayed if the Salesforce schema has a field marked as a name for the object.
3. Lookup and picklist fields will render values per the data that exists in the flow's record list. In previous releases the table would render the values in the Salesforce database. If a flow assignment step changes a lookup or picklist then that value will appear in the data table.

Version 2.0.0-rc.3 / 2.2.0

This version contains the following enhancements:

1. Lookup fields that are polymorphic will have their parent's name displayed if the lookup has less than 10 parent types. In the previous release all polymorphic fields displayed the field label instead of the parent name. This change only applies to records with valid values in their Id fields. See FAQ for more information.
2. Various enhancements have been made to the Ultimate Edition's editing features. These are currently available for beta testing in the free edition. See FAQ for more information.
