

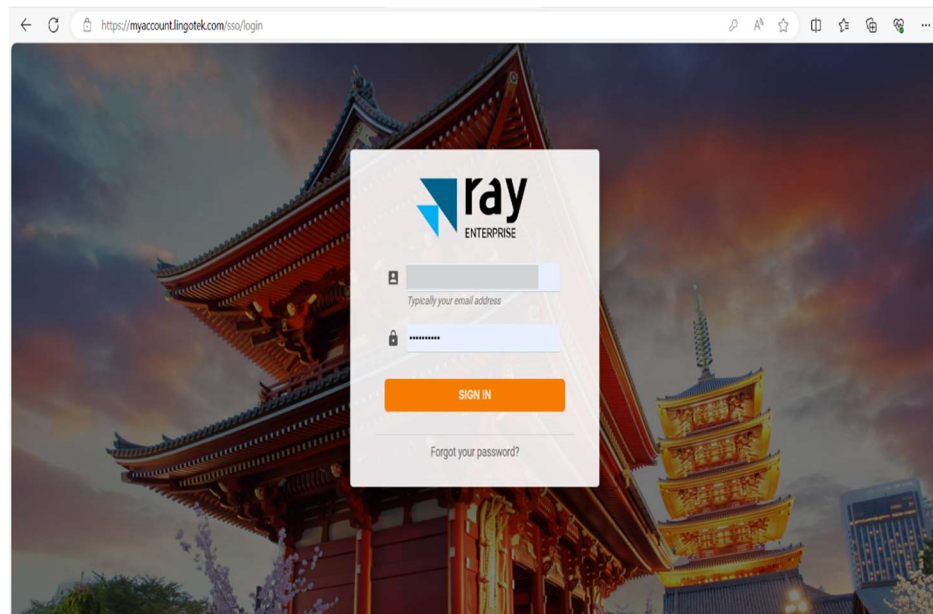
# Lingotek Setup

## 1. How to get the Lingotek Access Token

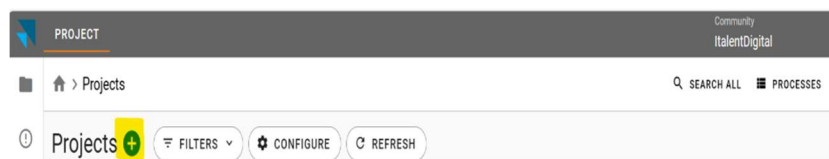
Upon registration with Lingotek at <https://devzone.lingotek.com/overview-5>, you'll be provided with an access token to start integrating into their sandbox environment.

## 2. Create Project in Lingotek and get Project ID.

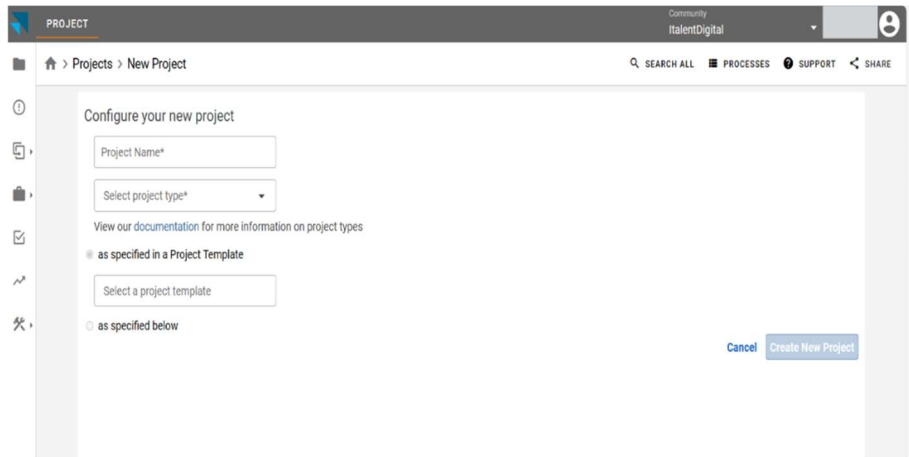
- Login to Lingotek using URL <https://sso.lingotek.com/login>



- Click on New Project. (If you don't want to use existing project)

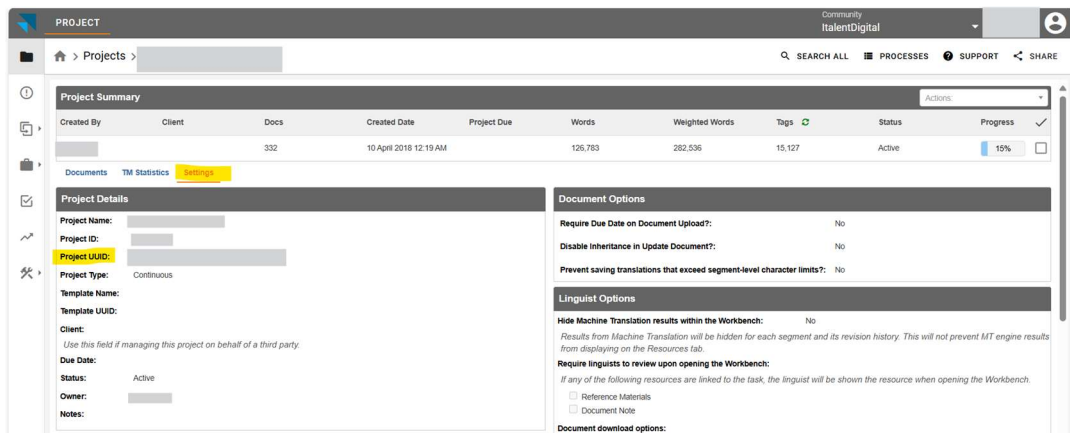


Provide the Project Name and select the project types,

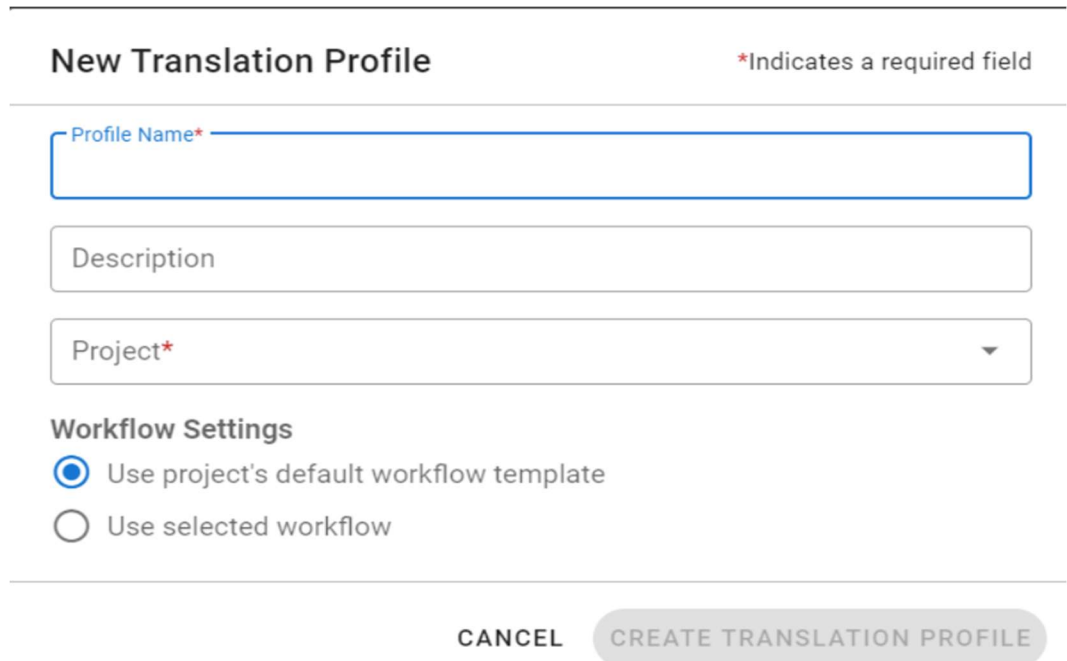
- Click on the “resources” on the left side of the page and select “Translation Profiles”:

- For example: In the below link the after the “/translationProfiles/” an ID is seen that is translation profile ID

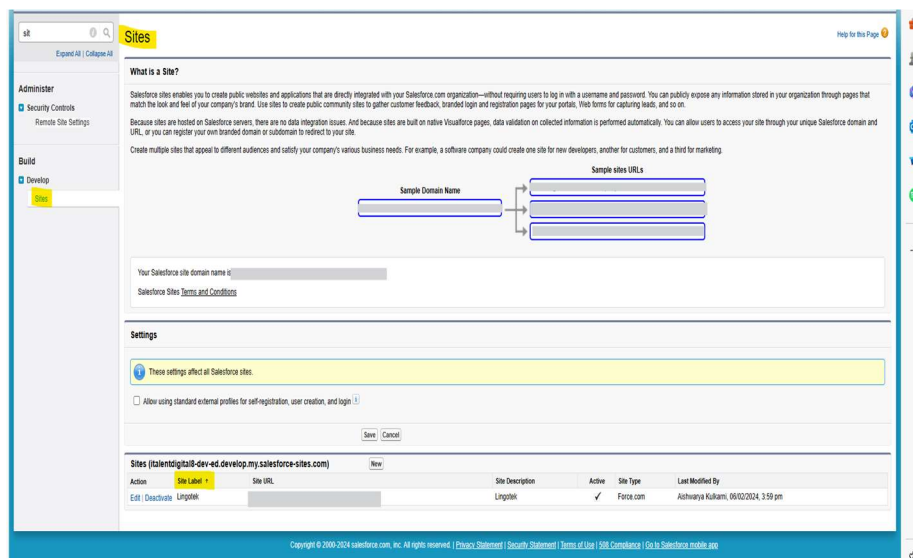


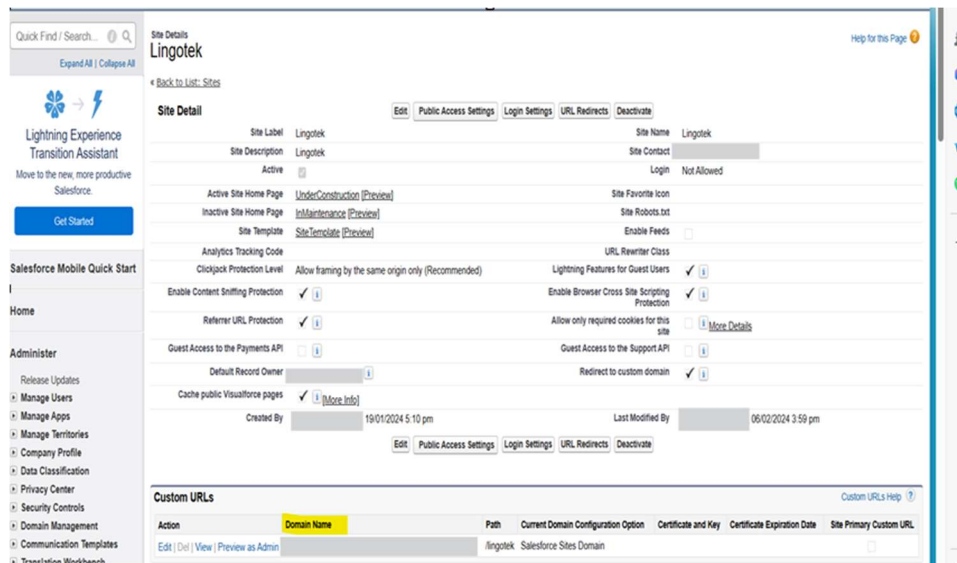
### 3.Add the Callback URL to the project

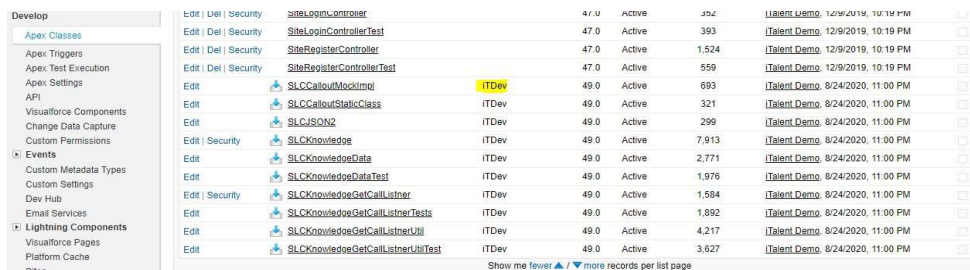

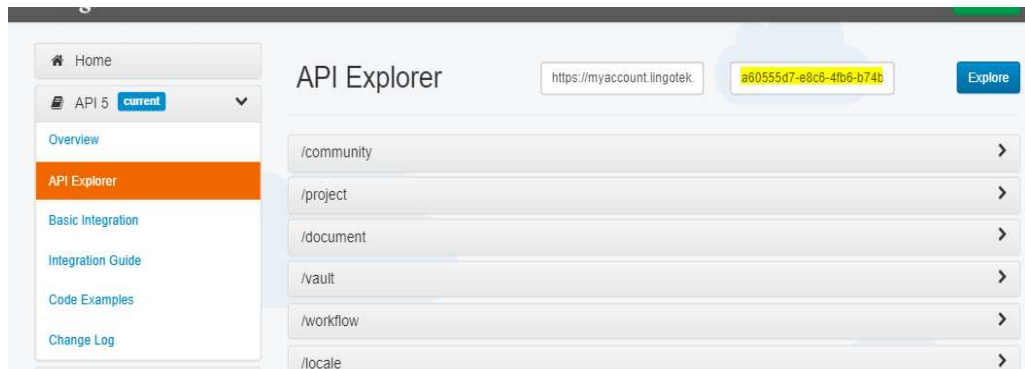

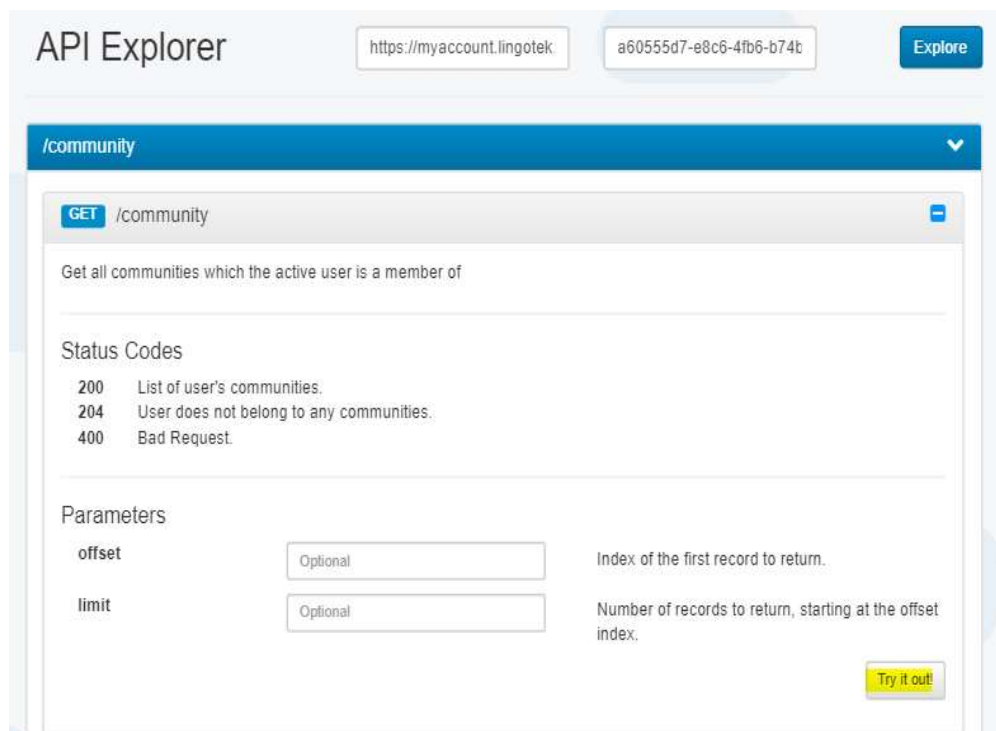
