Oktana RSS Feed - User Manual

Basic user manual and general use case guide for the Oktana RSS Feed component.



Overview

The purpose of this document is to guide you through the process of using rss. It explains the basic use of every action available in the component and every process that involves them.

The principal idea of this managed package once installed on a Salesforce Organization is to view on that interface the last news published in a rss selected by the user. The product was thought as an LWC solution that can be used in any Salesforce org Production or Sandbox as a tool to have fast access to the different rss storage by de user limited to five items per user.

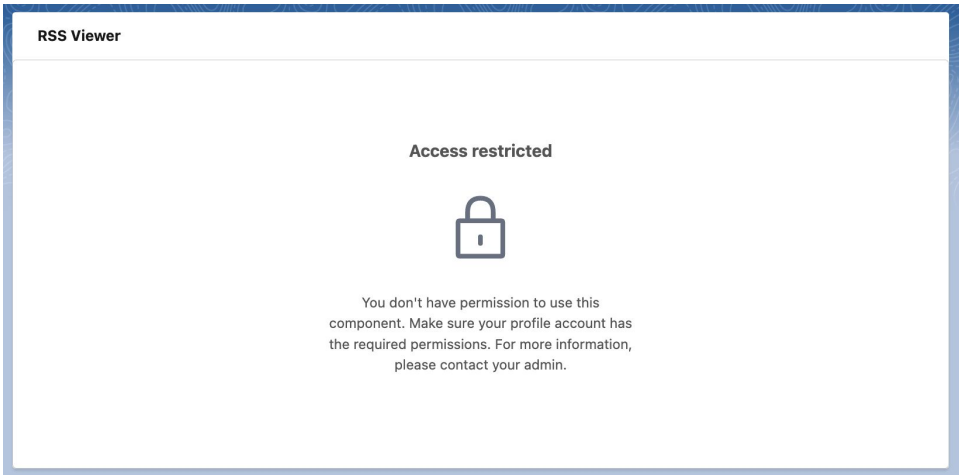
This document is intended for users with basic knowledge in record-based system management, it includes all the basic actions explained in the simplest way possible, so it can reach and be easy to understand for general users.

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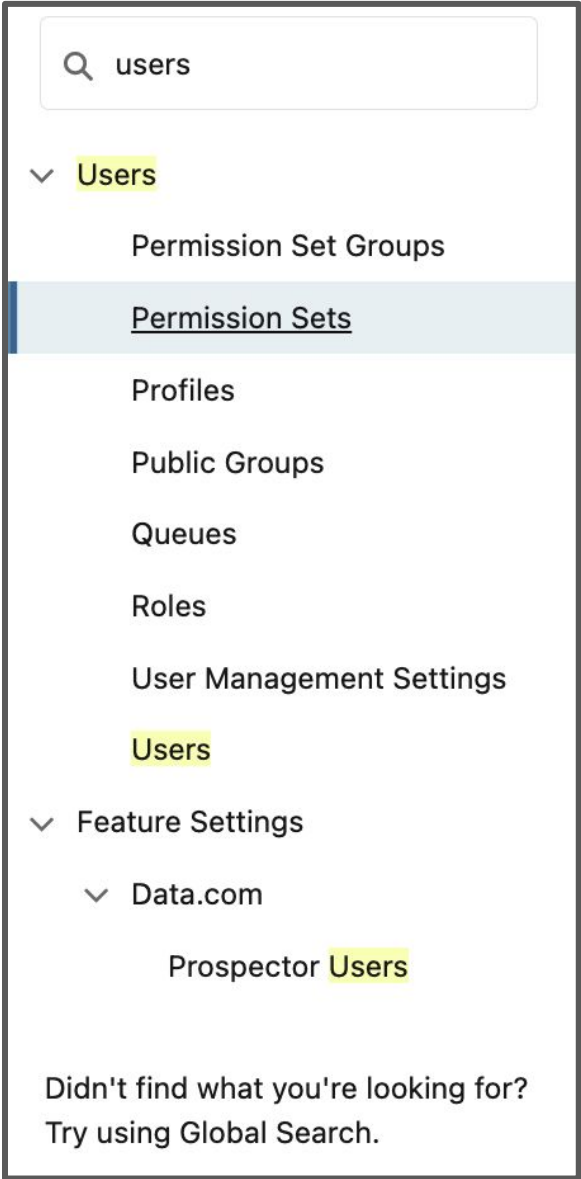
Adding Permission Set

If the logged users is a **System Administrator** would have access to the component without any additional configuration. Otherwise, it would need a permission set assigned and will probably see something like the image shown:



To fix this issue, it's necessary to assign the permission set to the desired users.

- Go to **Setup**.
- In the 'Quick Find' write *Users*.
- Click in "Permission Sets".

Finally, the user will be able to work with the Rss component.

Product Perspective

The product was thought as an LWC that can be used in any Salesforce org Production or Sandbox as a tool to see the latest news from the rss that user choose, the user must save the Rss that he wishes to see the news with a limit of 5 Rss.

The Component uses an Apex class that calls the endpoint associated with the rss to get xml data and parse it before sending to the component and another apex controller to serve data to a Lightning web component and manage the CRUD.

Features

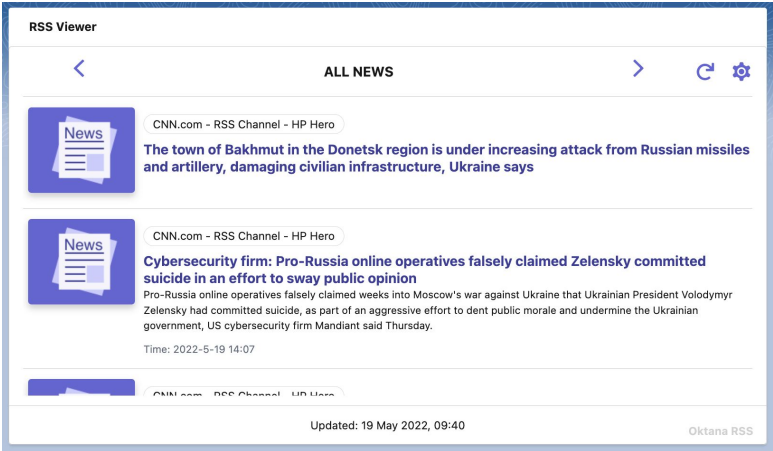
- Show current Rss.
- Change between rss in a list of maximum 5 rss.
- Refresh for latest news.
- Load More News.
- Add, Edit and Delete Rss.

Users Overview

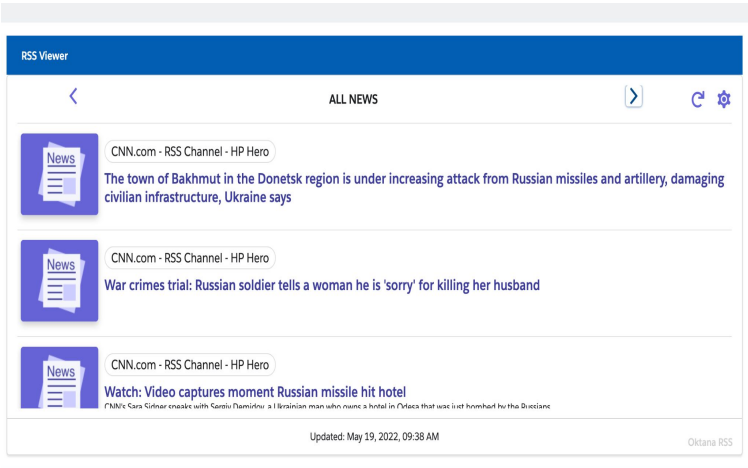
The permissions to access the package must be managed by the system administrator at the time of the package being installed it can be assigned to:

- The system administrator.
- All Salesforce Org users.
- Group of users with a specific profile.
