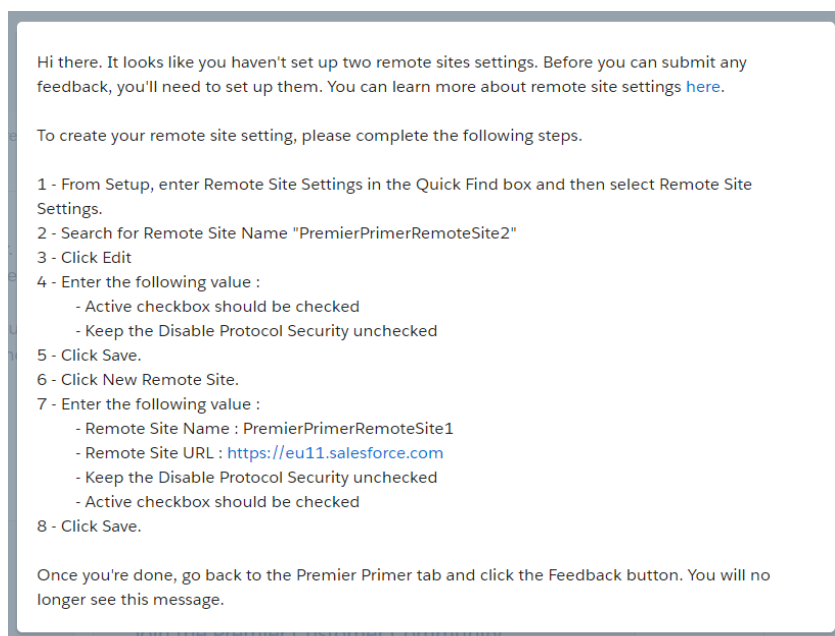

Before installing a package to your Salesforce org, please make sure to understand the instructions in the following link: [Help Article](#)

Please Note:

If you are manually updating Standard Feature Finder from a version that does not contain Feedback to a version that contains the Feedback mechanism, you will be prompted to allow third party access to cloudservices.my.salesforce.com when installing the app and prompted to set up the following remote site setting when you click the “Feedback” button.



Hi there. It looks like you haven't set up two remote sites settings. Before you can submit any feedback, you'll need to set up them. You can learn more about remote site settings [here](#).

To create your remote site setting, please complete the following steps.

- 1 - From Setup, enter Remote Site Settings in the Quick Find box and then select Remote Site Settings.
- 2 - Search for Remote Site Name "PremierPrimerRemoteSite2"
- 3 - Click Edit
- 4 - Enter the following value :
 - Active checkbox should be checked
 - Keep the Disable Protocol Security unchecked
- 5 - Click Save.
- 6 - Click New Remote Site.
- 7 - Enter the following value :
 - Remote Site Name : PremierPrimerRemoteSite1
 - Remote Site URL : <https://eu11.salesforce.com>
 - Keep the Disable Protocol Security unchecked
 - Active checkbox should be checked
- 8 - Click Save.

Once you have approved the necessary third party access and set up the necessary remote site settings you can submit feedback following the instructions provided in the prompt.

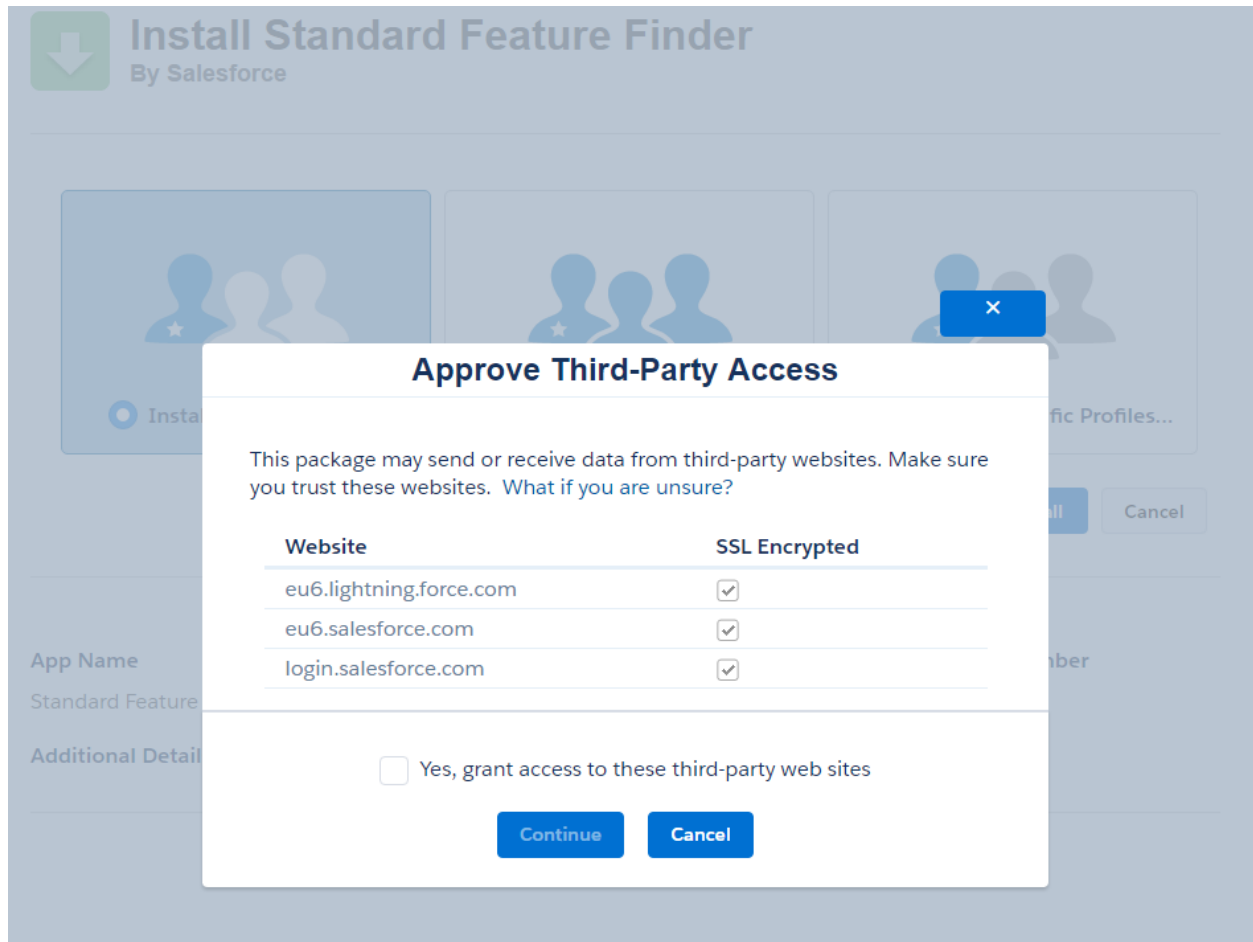
You will be prompted to approve third party access. The app retrieves Salesforce past releases features data from an external Salesforce org, so data is not stored in your Salesforce org and does not count against your data storage limits.

The app does not send any of your data; it only receives past releases data using secure encrypted transactions.

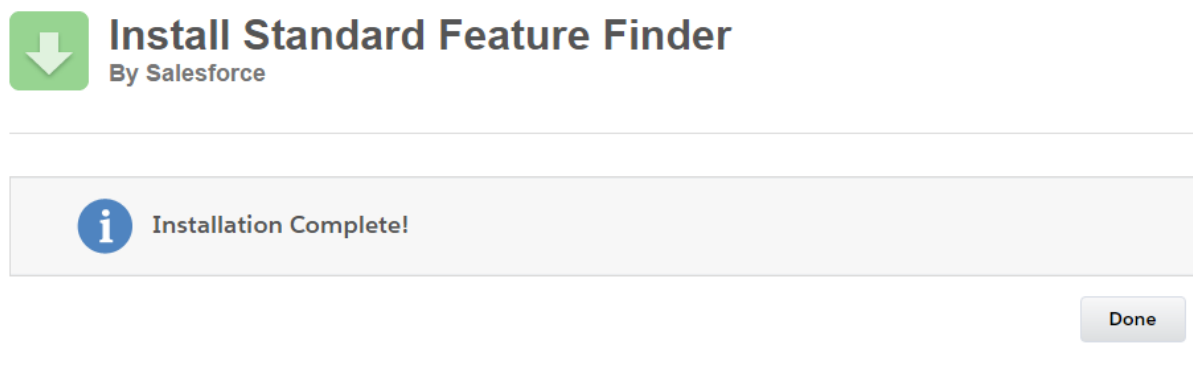

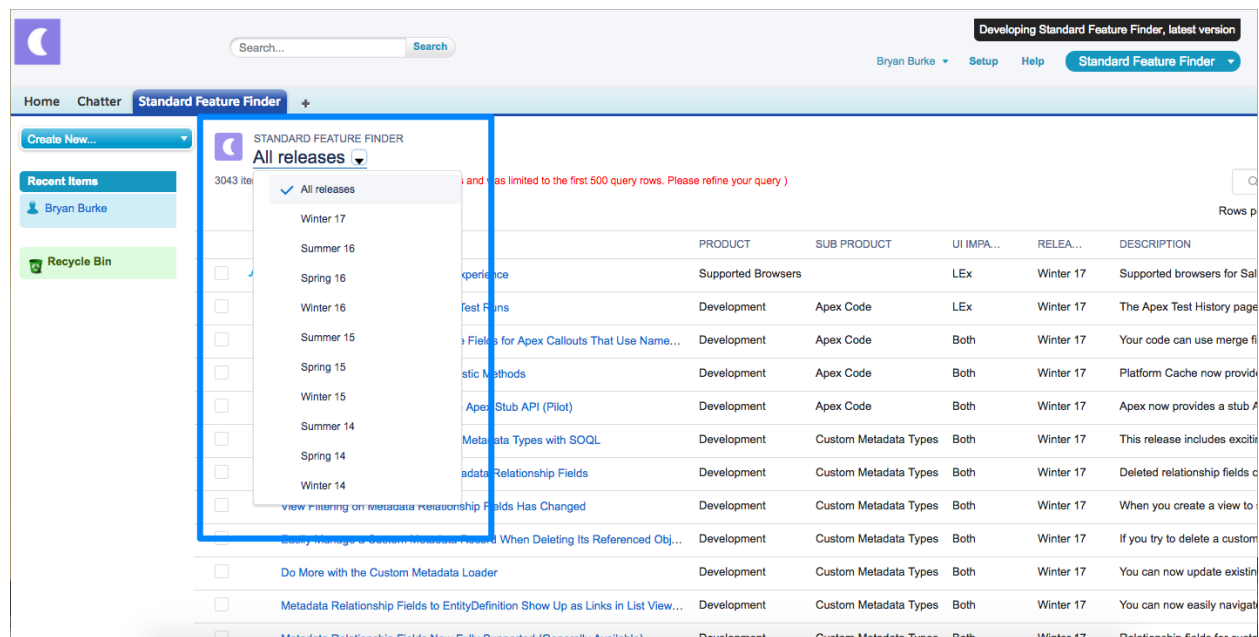

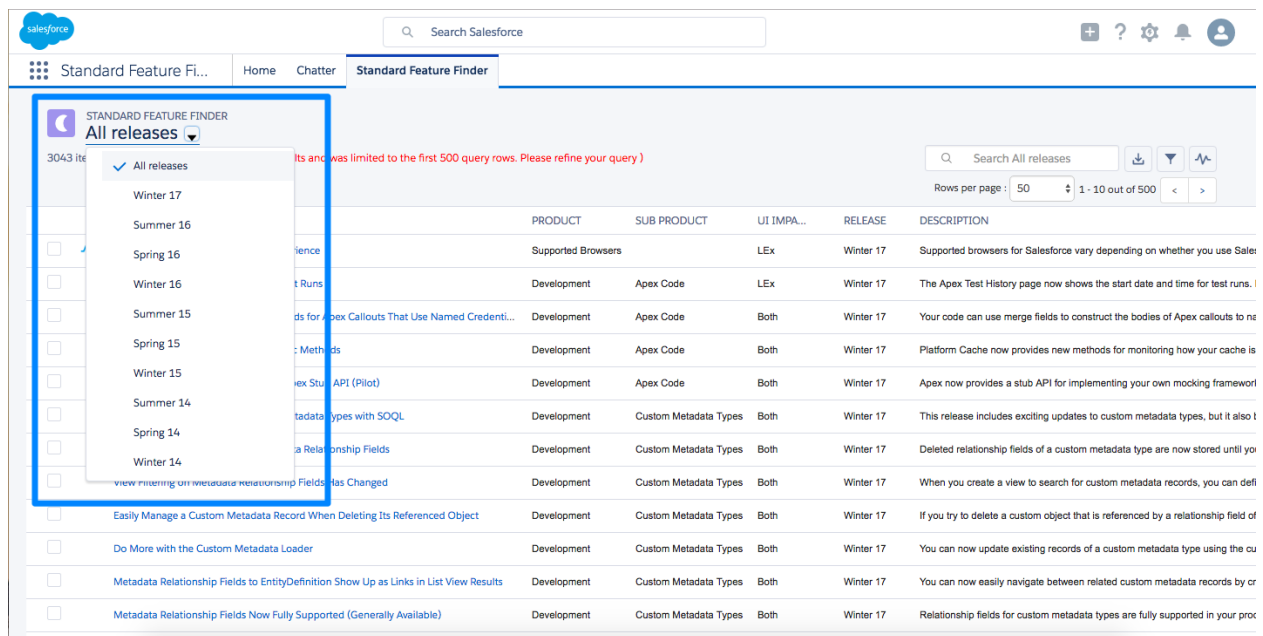

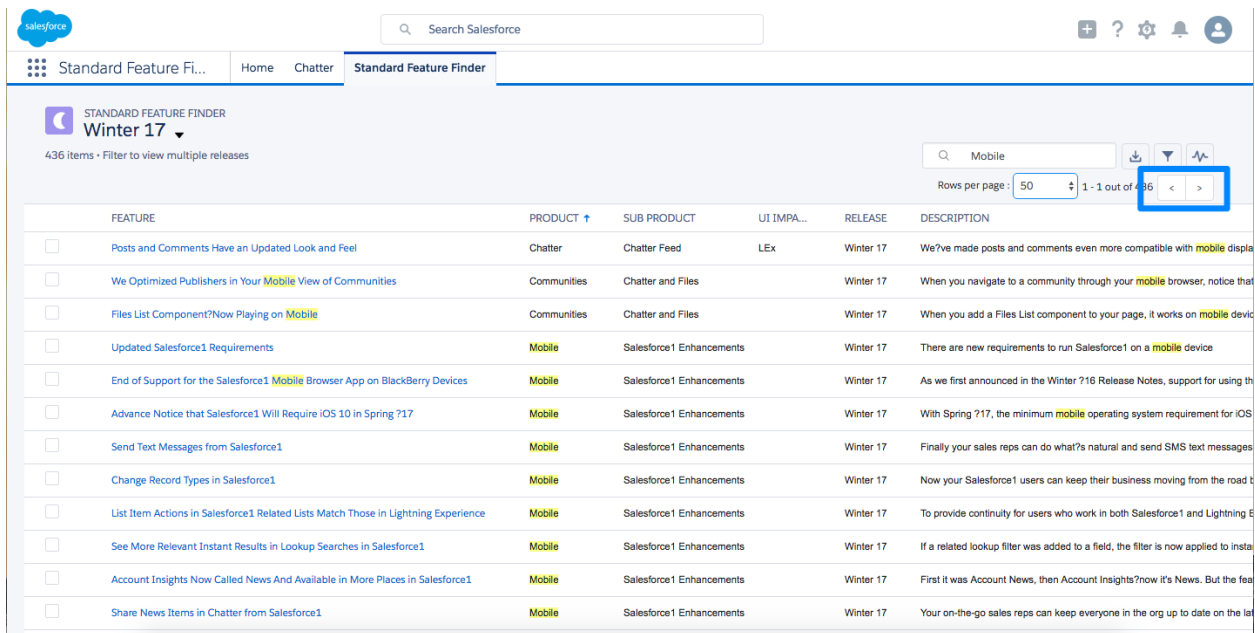
