Installation and Configuration Guide

System Requirements

Weather Company Weather Focus is supported for all Salesforce editions; Lightning Experience must be enabled. The component is not supported in Salesforce Classic. The component is supported on all browsers that are supported for Lightning Experience (see [Supported Browsers for Lightning Experience](#) in the Salesforce documentation).

Installing the component

Prerequisite: Ensure that Lightning Experience is enabled (see [Enable Lightning Experience](#)).

To install the component:

1. In the Salesforce AppExchange, go to the Weather Focus listing and click **Get It Now**.
2. If prompted, log in to the AppExchange.
3. Specify component installation in production or a sandbox.
4. Review and agree to the terms and conditions, and click **Confirm and Install**.
5. Select the users or profiles for which you want to install the component and click **Install**.
6. If prompted, select the check box to grant access to third-party web sites.

Configuring the component

After you install the component, add it to your account and contact pages by editing the pages in the Lightning App Builder. *Requirement:* You must have administrative privileges to edit pages.

To configure the component:

1. In Salesforce, click the Accounts or Contacts tab and select an existing account or contact.
2. Click the Setup icon () and select **Edit Page** to open the Lightning App Builder.
3. In the Lightning Components list, scroll down to the **Custom – Managed** section.
4. Click **Weather Company Weather Focus** and drag the component to any place on the page.
Tip: You can add multiple instances of this component to a page and associate each with a different address type (e.g., one instance of the component is associated with the billing address and another instance is associated with the shipping address).
5. In the properties pane, configure the component's properties:
 - a. Select the address type for which to display weather information. By default, the component uses the mailing address for contacts and the shipping address for accounts.
 - b. Select the default type of units to display.
6. Save and activate the updated pages. The component will now be displayed on all account or contact records.

Restrictions

The component shows data for locations in the U.S. and Canada only. The user interface is available in English only.
