Introduction

Group your Salesforce records into lists undisturbed by filters or field values with Stratus360's Static List.

The Static List holds onto records in lists from the time the Static List was created. Keeping the record information dynamic, records in Static Lists stays unchanged until the users manually make adjustments to the list. Each Static List includes data tables of meaningful fields and exportable CSV tables, to make information extraction easy and fast.

The Static List User Guide provides a Quick Start with the Static list as well as help users familiarize with its function. This guide also assists in troubleshooting any problems the user might face.

- Creating a list of records that are not based on filters
- Categorizing records and fields using Static Lists
- Viewing all fields within Static Lists in one data table
- Grouping Static Lists across many objects
- Designing hierarchy systems with a Static List of Static Lists

Before you get Started

Learn about the two essential components that requires your special attention:

- The Static List Buttons
- List Details Page

Let's delve into the Static List basics before we get started.

Static List Buttons

The Static List Buttons are "Add to Lists" and "Show Static Lists". These buttons are available on the upper right corner of object list views for users to perform Static List actions. Note that these Static List Buttons are visible on all list views except for "Recently Viewed".



Add to List

This button allows the user to create a Static List or add records to a Static List. Users will be directed to either "Create New List" or "Add to **List**" according to different conditions:

Create New List

- No pre-existing list in the selected object; or
- No records were selected

Add to List


 There are pre-existing Static Lists and records are selected.

Show Static Lists

This button allows the user to view the Static Lists within an object or show all Static Lists that contain one or more selected records. In the List object, this button shows all the List of Lists or show all List of Lists that contain one or more selected Static Lists.

List Details Page

The List Details Page presents all information such as records and fields regarding a certain Static List.

Action Bar

The Action Bar consists of buttons to create actions related to the Static List data table.

Edit Fields	This allows the user to add, remove and order the displayed fields on
	the data table.

Add Items This allows the user to add new items to the list.

Export Data This converts the List Item data table into a downloadable CSV file.

Change Owner: The user can change the owner of the current Static List. **Delete**: This deletes the Static List you are currently on.

Selection Bar

The Selection Bar contains a button that requires the user to select records in the List Item data table.

Remove

This allows the user to remove any selected items in the data table from the Static List.


List Item Data Table

The List Item data table displays Salesforce records and fields within a Static List.

Details

This allows the user to navigate to the record details page of the respective row.

The Details button is unavailable if the record referenced by a List Item is not found because the server is unable to find the record that is referenced by the List Item.



Lookup Fields

Any lookup field contains a link that redirects the user to the details page of the lookup.

Static List Quick Start

Learn how to use the Static List after the administrator setup process is complete. We will use the "Account" object as an example in the following processes.



Creating a New Static List


- 1. Go to an object after the administrator completed the List Type setup.
- 2. Visit any list view of the selected object.

The "Add to List" and "Show Static List" buttons appear on all **List Views except for "Recently** Viewed".

3. Select records in the list view.




4. Click on the "Add to Lists" button.




Creating a New Static List

5. In "Create New List", enter the "List Name" and select fields to display in your Static List.




6. Click the "Create New List" button. A pop-up with a success message will appear if the creation was successful on the page you just created.




Finding your New List

- 1. Go to the object that contains your new Static List.
- 2. Click "Show Static Lists".

The "Add to List" and "Show Static List" buttons appear on all List Views except for "Recently Viewed".




3. All Static Lists of that object will be displayed.



Editing Fields in a Static List


- 1. Click the "Edit Fields" (Edit Fields) button in the List Details Page.
- 2. Select a field and click the arrow buttons to arrange the field to the preferred side and order.




- This button adds the selection to the Static List.
- This button removes the selection from the Static List.
- This button moves the selected field to the left of the List Details Page data table
- This button moves the selected field to the right of the List Details Page data table .
- 3. Click the "Save" button.

Adding Items to a Static List

1. Select the records you would like to create a Static List.




2. Click the "Add to Lists" button.



3. Select the preferred Static List and click "Add to List(s)"

You can add the selected items to multiple Static Lists at once.




Removing Items from a Static List

Items removed from the Static List will not delete the object record.

1. Click on the "Show Static Lists" button.

The "Add to List" and "Show Static List" buttons appear on all List Views except for "Recently Viewed".

- 2. Select the Static List of the item you wish to remove.
- 3. Select the item and click "Remove".



4. A warning message will appear. Click the "Remove" button.




A pop-up with a success message will appear if the removal was successful.



Deleting a Static List




1. Click on the "Show Static Lists" button.




2. Select the Static List you wish to remove.



3. Click the "Delete" button.



4. A warning message will appear. Click the "Delete" button.



A pop-up with a success message will appear if the deletion was successful.



Advanced Static List

The Advanced Static List Section shows higher level Static List uses. This section contains:

- List Object List View
- Adding Items to a Static List in the List Details Page
- Showing All Statics Lists that Contain a Specific Record
- Creating a Static List of Static Lists

- Exporting Static Lists into a CSV File


List Object List View

The List object is a pre-installed object that helps users manage all their Static Lists created across different objects within the list view.

1. Click on the "List" object ✓ All Items App Launcher Approval Requests Calendar Brokers Campaigns List Items Lists Macros



2. Select a list view other than "Recently Viewed".


3. All Static Lists created will be listed in the List List View.




To check Static Lists of Static Lists (in short, Lists of Lists), click the "Show Static Lists".

Adding Items to a Static List in the List Details Page

1. Select a Static List from the List object to open the List Details page.



2. Click on the "Add Items" button.




3. Select the record(s) and click the "Add" button.


Showing All Statics Lists that Contain a Specific Record

1. Click on the object from the App




2. Select a record(s) from a list view other than "Recently Viewed".



3. Click "Show Static Lists".



This will only show the Static Lists that contains the selected records.




Creating a Static List of Static Lists

This function allows users to create a Static List of Static Lists (which will be referred to "List of Lists); it is useful to create a hierarchical system. Static Lists from any object can be grouped together under the same List of Lists.

1. Click on the "List" object from the App Launcher ...




2. Click the "Add to Lists" button after selecting the Static Lists from a list view that is not "Recently Viewed".




3. Enter the "List Name" and select the fields to display.

If you have made List of Lists on the same object in the past, the "Add to List" will take you to the default page "Add to List" instead of "Create New List".



Creating a Static List of Static Lists


4. Click the "Create New List" button. A pop-up success message will appear if the action is successful.




Showing All Static List of Static Lists



- 2. Select a list view other than "Recently Viewed".
- 3. Click the "Show Static Lists" button.




All Static Lists created will be displayed under "All List Lists".



Exporting Static Lists into a CSV File




- 2. On the List list view, select the Static List you wish to export.
- 3. Click the "Export Data" button.



The "Export Data" button only downloads the information visible on the data table. The Static List data table will be downloaded into an Excel CSV file listing the account name and fields.

Troubleshooting

The List object data table should not be modified as errors are bound to happen.





Error 1: Failed to get Data. Data has been corrupted, 1 invalid item(s) found. Consult to User Guid

Reason: A List Item is referring to a different Object ID than the current Static List Object ID. If the SObject and the object of the List Items do not match, the server is unable to find the List Item in the Static List.

Solution: Go to the **List Items Tab** to delete the **List Item** that has the error.



Error 2: Failed to get Object. Data has been corrupted, 'xxx' does not exist. Consult to User Guide.

Reason: The SObject the list is referring to does not exist. This happens when the user directly modifies the SObject of the list.

Solution: Edit the list for the object to link to the original object.

Troubleshooting



Error 3: Failed to get Fields. Data has been corrupted, 'xxx' is not a field of a certain object. Consult to User Guide.

Reason: The **Fields** section of the list contains a non-existent field. This happens when the user modifies the Fields of the Static List.

Solution: Delete the fields that are referenced in the error message.

Glossary

D

Data Table² - An HTML table that's defined by iterating over a set of data, displaying information about one item of data per row. The body of the data table contains one or more column components that specify what information should be displayed for each item of data. The data set can include up to 1,000 items, or 10,000 items when the page is executed in read-only mode.

F

Field³ - is a part of an object that holds a specific piece of information, such as a text or currency value.

L

List Details Page - a Detail page for the List object.

Detail⁴ - A page that displays information about a single object record. The detail page of a record allows users to view the information, whereas the edit page allows you to modify it.

List View⁵ - A list display of items (for example, accounts or contacts) based on specific criteria. Salesforce provides some predefined views.

In the Agent console, the list view is the top frame that displays a list view of records based on specific criteria. The list views users can select to display in the console are the same list views defined on the tabs of other objects. You cannot create a list view within the console.

List Item - an item that is linked to a record of an object in a static list.

List Items Data Table - is a data table that contains records of list items.

List of Lists - an is a Static List that possesses multiple Static Lists.

List Object - an object for the individual user to manage their Static Lists and List of Lists.

Glossary

List Type - are objects that are conditioned by the administrator to create and contain Static Lists.

0

Object - allows users to store information in their Salesforce organization. The object is the overall definition of the type of information you are storing.

S

Static List – a stationary list of records on an object.

Static List Buttons -- the static list buttons include "add to list" and "show Static List" that allows the users to create and see their Static Lists.

Static List of Static Lists - is a Static List that contains many Static Lists.

W

Warning Message - a notification that alerts users the reason for an error or a precautionary tip.
