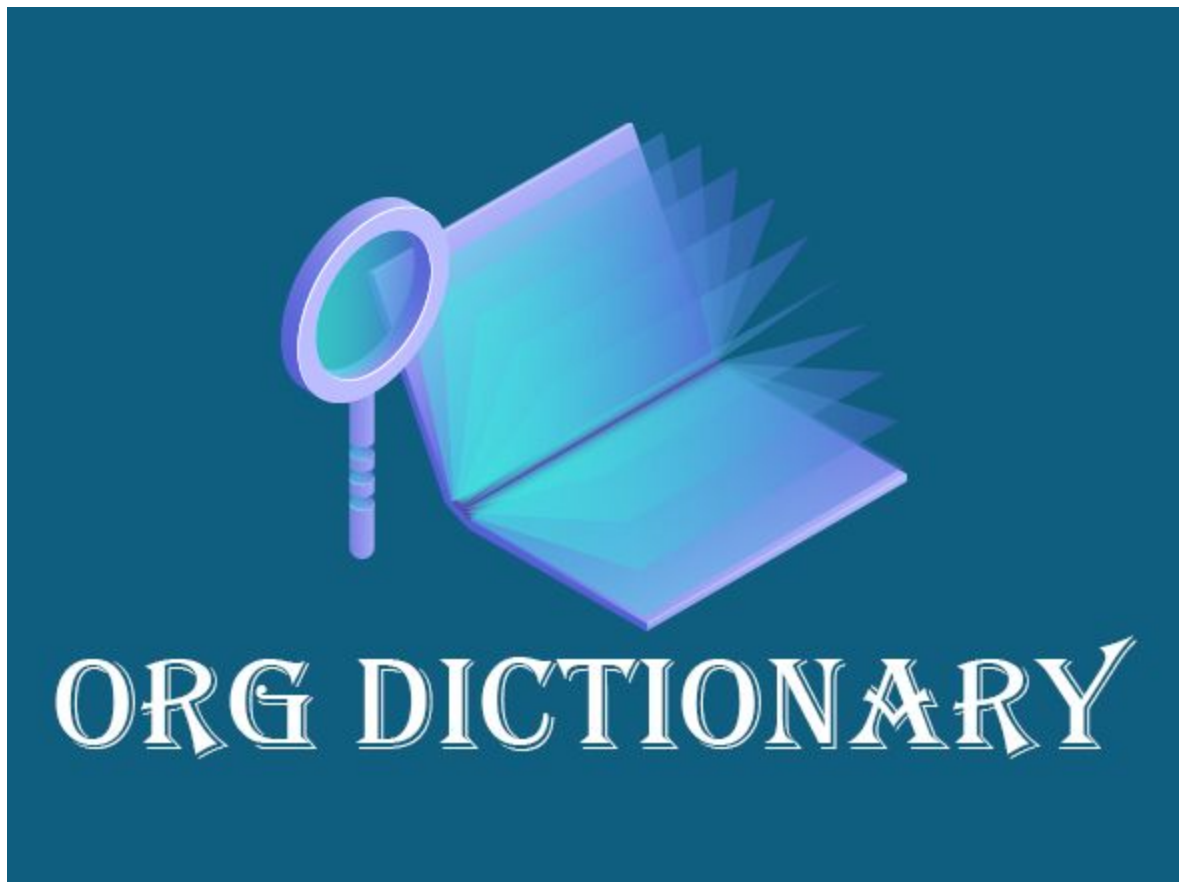


ORG DICTIONARY (INSTALLATION GUIDE)





Step 1: Pre Installation Step

Note: Enable the domain before starting using this package. If the domain is already enabled, please move to Step 2 directly.

Steps to enable domain

1. Go to Set-Up
2. Type My Domain in the search box
3. Create a domain for the Org and “Deploy to Users”.

Step 2: Installation steps

1. Open the URL below to Install Org Dictionary

Use this URL to install the package into any organization:

2. Select any one option: Install for admin, Install for all users, or install for specific profiles. Click on install.

Here, If a user has selected **Install for Admins only**, then Admin(user) will have to assign the permission set (**All Access**) for all those who will use this package.

If this package is installed for the end-user, then there is no need to assign the permission set.



Step 3: Post Installation Steps

1. Create a Remote Site Setting in the Org
 - a. Go to Setup
 - b. Type Remote Site Setting in the search box.
 - c. Click the new button.

Remote site setting --> your org new URL (After enabling the domain).

For example- <https://orgdictionary-dev-ed.lightning.force.com> and replace [.lightning.force.com](https://orgdictionary-dev-ed.lightning.force.com) with --c.visualforce.com.

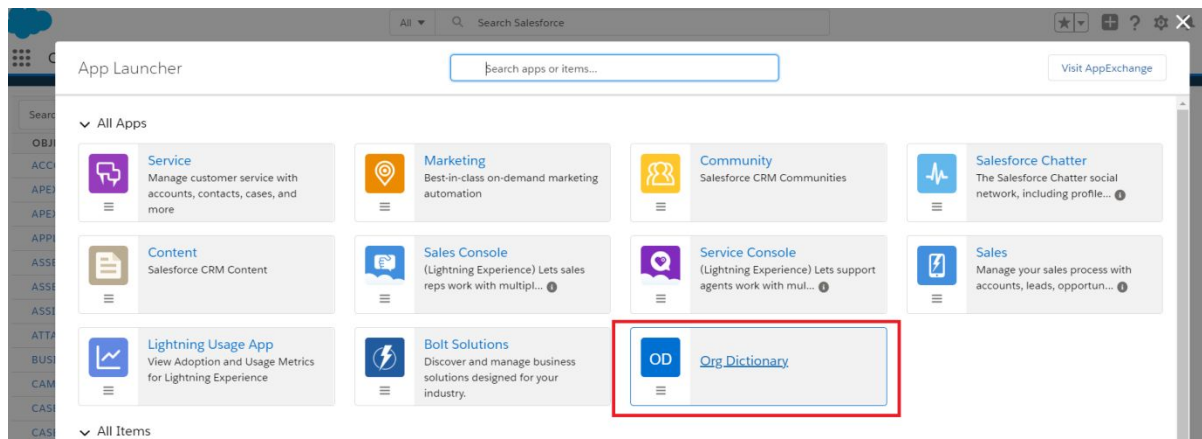

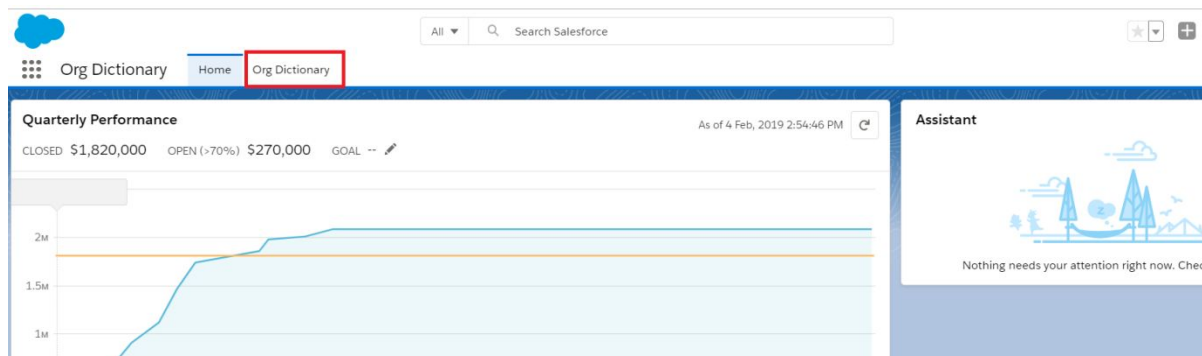


Step 4: Run the App

Then click on the Org Dictionary tab.

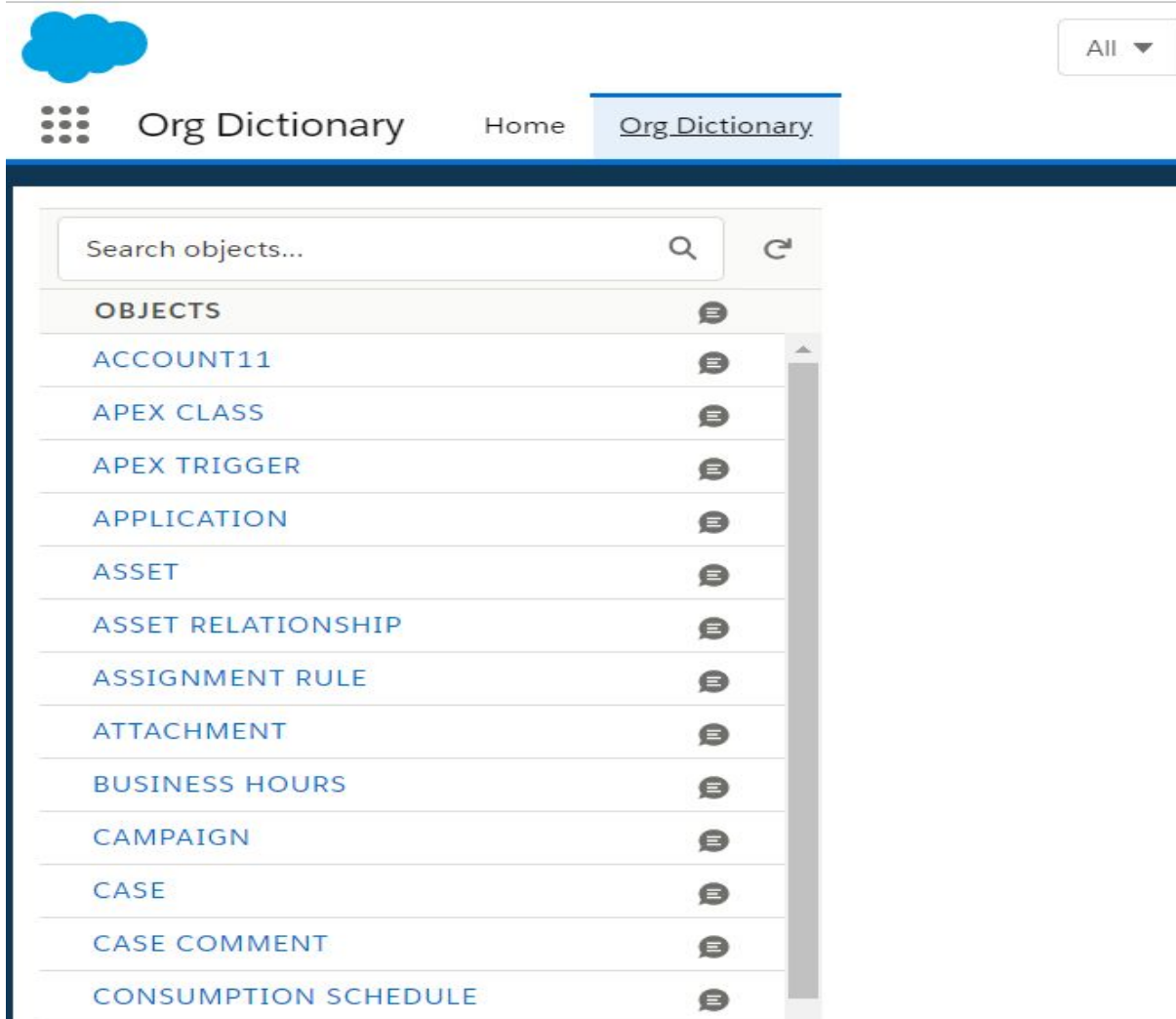


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It will open the landing page where a user can find the list of objects.
