

PMT Managed - Admin Guide

1. Initial Setup

- Assign PMT Global Admin permission set to the system admin user who is setting up the app.
- Update all picklist fields on following objects as per the business requirements:
 - PMT Project
 - PMT Program
 - PMT Phase
 - PMT Task
 - Resource Allocation
- Update configuration in custom metadata type
Go to Setup > Custom Code > Custom Metadata Type > PMT Settings > Manage > Default > Edit

Label	Default	Description
PMT_ActivateResourceAllocationTrigger	TRUE	This activates/deactivates the trigger which automates the project sharing. Keep this false, if your sharing model is public read/write for project
PMT_Default_Resource_Availability	100	The default availability percentage assigned to the users while creating the availabilities
PMT_FiscalYearStartMonth	2	This indicates the start of the fiscal year. The default value is 2 which means it starts from Feb. This setting should only be updated at the beginning only, subsequent changes can lead into inconsistencies.
PMT_NumberOfYearsAvailabilityToBeCreated	2	The rolling number of years for which the availability is created by the scheduler

- Add the field “Is PMT User consider for Availability” to the user page layout.
- Check the checkbox called “Is PMT User consider for Availability” on the user profiles for the users who should be available as resources for resource planning.
- Automate the availability creation on user creation/update
 - Create a new process on User object if no existing process with start criteria based on the requirements
 - Add new criteria based on when you would like to create new availability
 - Add action > Type > Process and select action > PMT - Create Resource Availability on User activation
 - Activate the process
 - Update the user records with “Is PMT User consider for Availability” as checked

2. Additional Configuration (Optional)

- Setup approval process on the task
- Setup email notifications using process builder as per the business requirements
- Install and configure [home/child kanban](#) appexchange package for kanban view on project
- Enable Path, if not enabled already, from Setup > User Interface > Path Settings > Enable Path to use path on the PMT task.

- Scheduler to create the availability automatically need to be configured. Here is the sample code that you need to configure. And then schedule this apex code to run at a specific frequency

3. Security Setup

These are just guidelines for how to setup the sharing and visibility of the record based on our experience of PMT. But you can always potentially implement your own version of this. Here are couple of guidelines:

Option 1: Keep the security public

- Description:
 - This option opens up all records to all the users and there is no show/hide for based on criteria.
 - In this case only security applicable will be validation rules.
- Steps
 - Go to Setup > Sharing Settings
 - Open PMT Program, PMT Project and Resource Availability and change the sharing to public read/write.
- Pros
 - Easy setup and visibility
 - This model can be used by a small team where almost of all people are involved in all projects.
- Cons
 - Lacks security to hide the data based on project memberships

Option 2: Setup sharing and visibility for the records using trigger

- Description:
 - A trigger on the resource allocation object has been included in the package to automate the sharing of the project with the members.
 - As soon as the member is added to the project, the project is shared with the member.
 - Steps:
 - Go to Setup > Sharing Settings
 - Open PMT Project and change the sharing to private or private read/write based on the requirements.
 - Keep the PMT Program as public read only and Resource Availability as public read/write.
 - Pros
 - Handles the security of the data at a granular level
 - Cons
 - Complex to setup and maintain over the time

4. Assumptions

- Completion can only be marked at task level which then rolls up automatically to the phase and project.
- PMT is not completely supported in salesforce classic, some of the functionality will not work.
- 'DHTMLX' charts are being used for the gantt view is covered under these [terms](#).
- Kanban view is not provided as a part of the package but this [home/child kanban](#) appexchange package is recommended for the same.

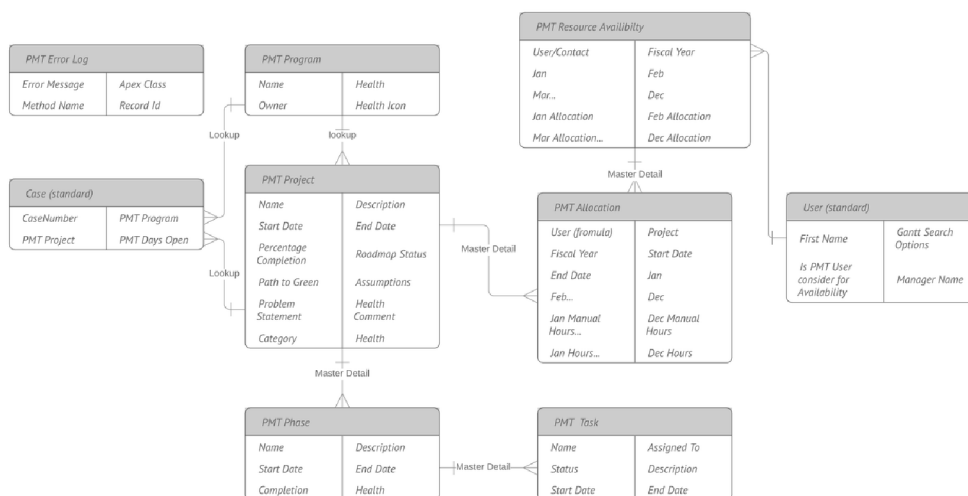
5. Technical Documentation

Object Description

	Label	Master Object	Description
1	PMT Program		Use in Project Management Tool to record Programs and related projects.
2	PMT Project		
3	PMT Phase	PMT Project	
4	PMT Task	PMT Phase	
5	PMT Resource Availability		Stores availability of a resource, which is used for allocation to project
6	PMT Resource Allocation	Resource Availability, PMT Project	Stores the allocation of the resource for a requirement
7	PMT Error Logs		Used to capture errors occurred operations.

Permission Sets and permission assignments

There are 3 permission sets included in the package:

- PMT Resource Planner : User with project access and allocation to the projects
- PMT App User : User with project and task access
- PMT Global Admin : Admin access to the PMT app

1	PMT Project	InitialStartDate_should_be_less	Initial End date must be after Initial Start date.
2		Path_to_Green_should_be_blank	Path to Green field should be used only for Late, At Risk or On Hold projects. Please use Health Comment for On Track projects
3		SOX_Comment_Blank_SOX_Impact_unchecked	SOX Comment should be blank if SOX Impact is not checked
4		SOX_comment_not_null_when_SOX_checked	SOX Comment should not be blank if SOX Impact is checked
5	PMT Phase	Kickoff_before_deadline	Phase End Date must be after Phase Start date.
6	PMT Task	Task_On_hold_Reason_not_null_if_On_Hold	On Hold Reason should not be Blank if Status is 'On Hold'.
7		Task_start_date_less_than_end_date	End Date must be after Start Date.
8	PMT Resource availability	Availability_cannot_be_more_than_100	Availability must be in between 0 and 100
9		Fiscal_Year_format_as_FYXX	Fiscal Year must be in the format of FYXX
