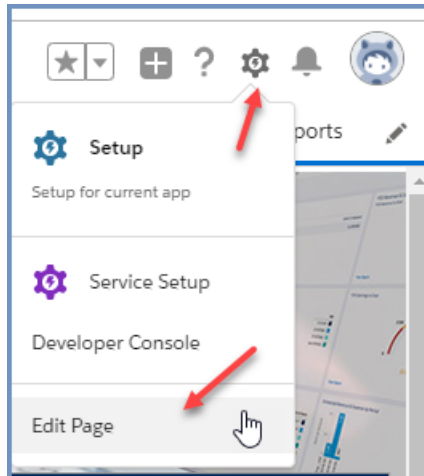


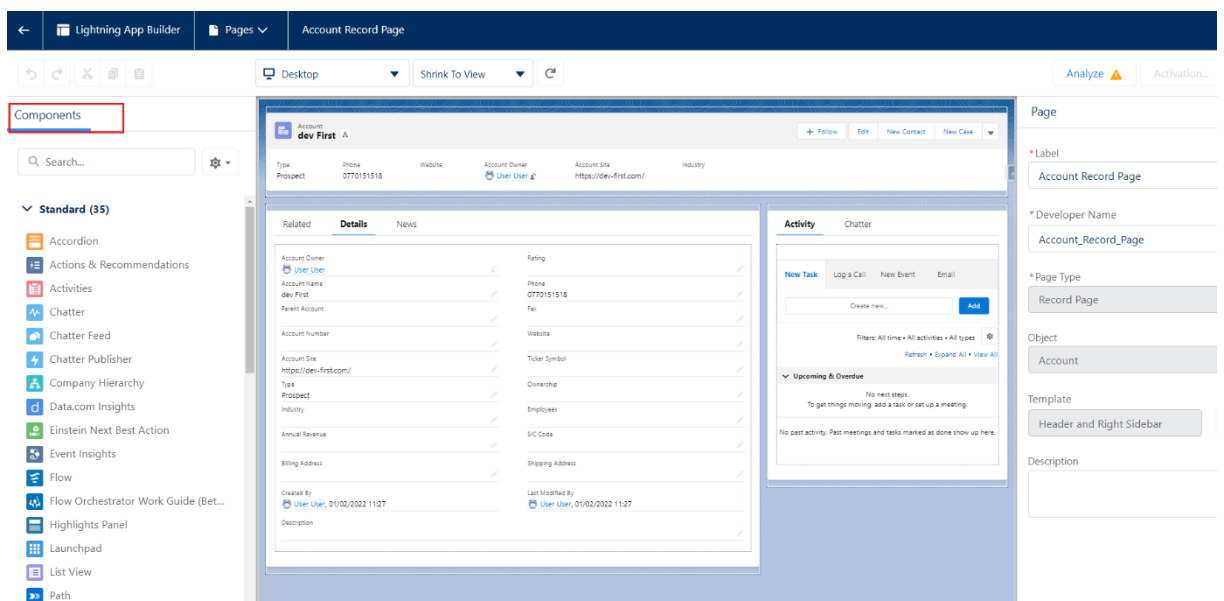
Edit a Page to Add a Lightning Component

Important : The screen captures in the steps below focuses in on adding the '**Count Account's Children**' component. However, these same steps can be used to select and add any Lightning component.

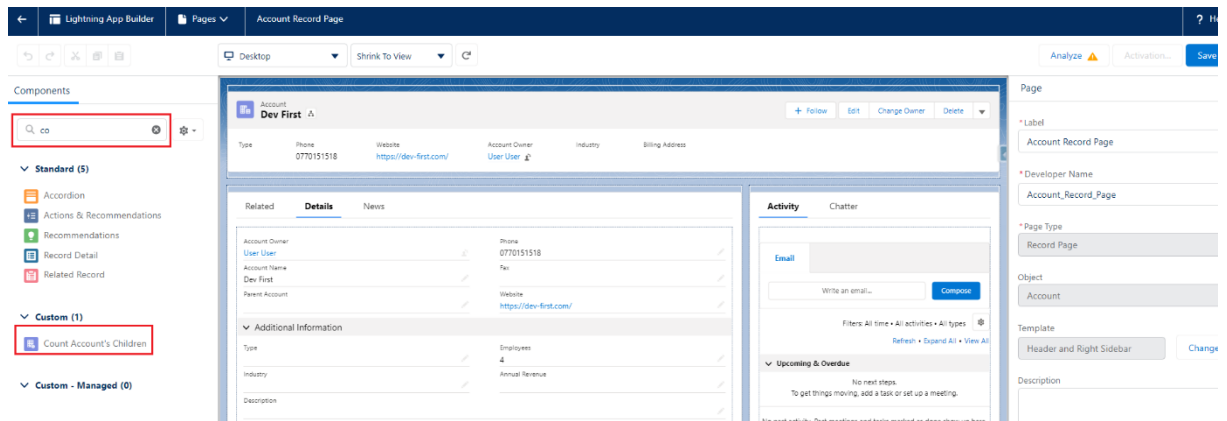
1. Display a Account record page.
2. Click the **Gear icon (Setup)** and select **Edit Page**.



The Lightning Components display on the left navigation pane.

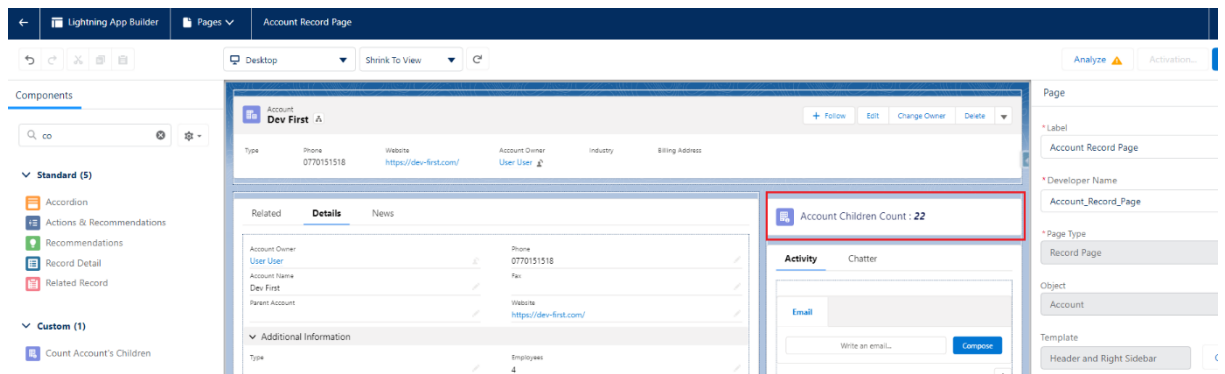


3. From the left navigation pane, scroll down the **Lightning Components** to select a component '**Count Account's Children**'

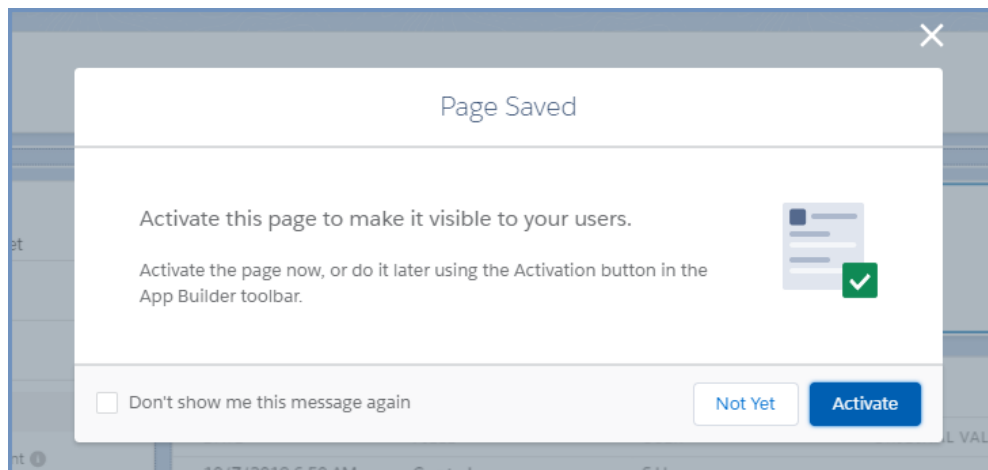


4. Click and drag the component into the right pane.

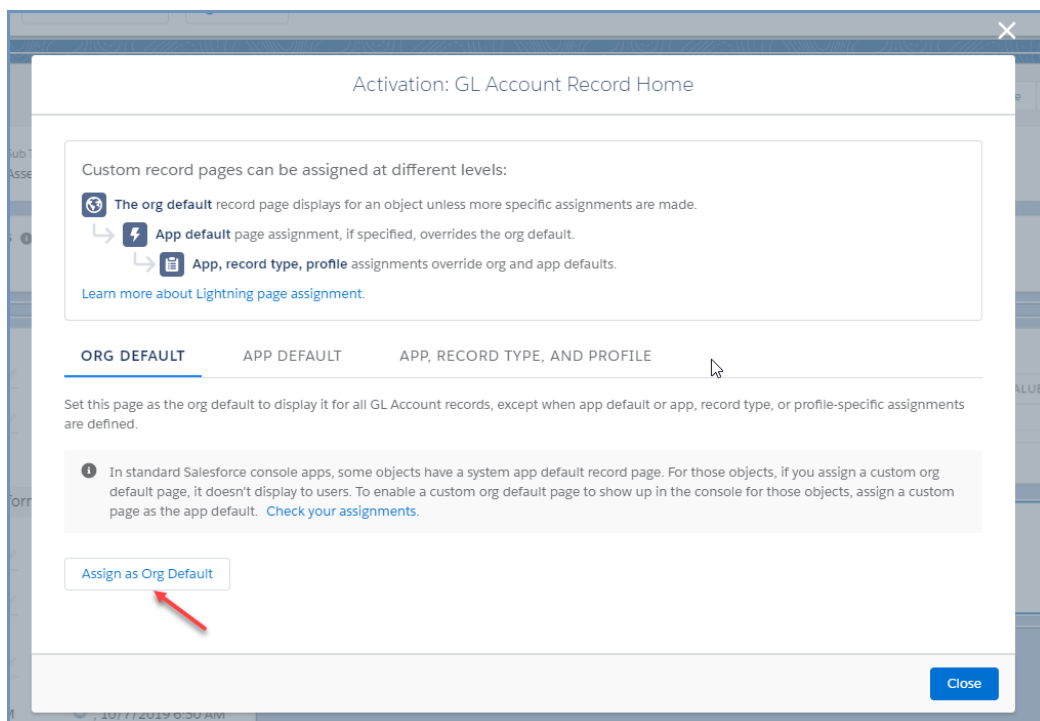
The selected component is framed in red as in the screen example below.



5. Drag and drop the component up or down based upon the location where you want it to display. You can also drag and drop the component to the right or left.
6. Click **Save**.



7. Click **Activate**.



8. Click **Assign as Org Default**.
