Overview

Our Fortune 100 client approached us to redesign their entire New Hire program, which included Instructor-led Training to a fully digitized experience. At any given point in time, there could be hundreds of “agents” in flight at different levels in the program. This was provided to them for their first year of employment including Onboarding, Essentials and Expansion phases of learning.

They needed to train Agents throughout the country while maximizing the Agents’ time without requiring in person training.

Client Objectives



- Redesign or create the New Agent training program as a fully digitized experience
- Reduce instructional time 40-60% as compared to classroom instruction, resulting in less time away from the job
- Remain focused on the core content necessary for the success of the New Agent
- Provide a high degree of engagement and interaction
- Allow employees to pause training, reread information, or test out of information they already know, reducing need for follow-up training, calls to help desks, etc

Approach

Redesign the entire curriculum of 100+ topics into digital eLearning modules.

Emphasis on:

- Short
- Engaging
- Interactive



Digital modules were enhanced through:

- Animated and white board videos
- Skill Builder sessions with managers
- Independent activities
